#### Barre History Collection

Deane C. Davis (1900-1990) Papers, 1877-1990, Bulk: 1960-1990 BHC 343-346, 339F, 340F, 529

#### Introduction

This collection contains a limited number of personal papers and photographs of Deane C. Davis, president of National Life Insurance Company and governor of Vermont, for the period 1969 to 1972. It is housed in four archival flip-top boxes, two flat boxes, and one folio volume; it consumes approximately 4 linear feet of shelf space. Additional items donated by grandson Michael Davis were added in October 2019.

## **Biographical Note**

Deane Chandler Davis was born in East Barre, Vermont, to Earle Russell Davis and Lois Salome Hillery on November 7, 1900. At age five he was sent to live with his grandparents on Pike Hill in Corinth, Vermont, due to the illness of his brother, Raymond Davis. He lived with his grandparents for two years and loved his life on the farm; it was there that he first developed a lifelong interest in Morgan horses. He graduated from Spaulding High School in Barre in 1918.

After continuing his education and eventually graduating from Boston University Law School in 1922, Davis became a lawyer in Barre, Vermont. He went on to serve in several public offices including as a member of the Barre City Council, as a state's attorney for Washington County, and as a superior court judge. He left his private law practice in 1940 to work for the National Life Insurance Company as their general counsel and president in 1950. He served as Chief Executive Officer of National Life from 1960 to 1966 and was subsequently chairman of the board (1966-1968). Deane C. Davis was the 74th Governor of Vermont, serving two terms from 1969 to 1973.

Deane C. Davis married Corinne Eastman on June 14, 1924, and the couple had three children: Deane C. Davis Jr. (who died in 1929 at age four in a house fire), Marian Davis and Thomas Davis. Following Corinne Eastman Davis' death, he remarried to Marjorie Phyllis Smith Conzelman of Barre, Vermont, and acquired two step-children, Peter and Patricia Conzelman. Deane C. Davis died in Berlin, Vermont, on December 8, 1990.

### **Scope and Content**

The collection contains limited personal papers and photographs of Deane C. Davis, a former president of National Life Insurance Company and the 74<sup>th</sup> governor of Vermont. Materials in the collection are divided into six series: personal memorabilia, political items, photographs, writings, video and audio, and miscellaneous. The photographs and writings comprise a substantial portion of the collection and primarily document Davis' activities from the late 1960s to the 1980s.

The photographic prints consist of a number of political and Republican Party subjects as well as equestrian images, including a photograph of Denny Emerson, a 1970 gold medalist,

riding Deane Davis' Morgan stallion, Lippitt Tweedle Dee. Other photographs consist primarily of color slides documenting a trip to Japan and various Southeast Asian countries, especially Malaysia, Thailand, and Cambodia, in 1966. Additional miscellaneous items within the collection include brochures, photographic prints, and color slides of trips to Korea and Japan in either 1966 or 1972. Two other photograph albums presented to Davis by the Japanese government in 1972 chronicle a U.S. Governor's Conference to Hyogo Prefectural, held in April 1972.

Writings in the collection include drafts of papers and articles as well as two copies of published books by Deane. The books, *Life Insurance & Business Purchase Agreements* (1950) and *Professional – Partnership, Purchase Plans* (1961), appear to reflect Davis' professional expertise. The drafts of his other works relate to other interests including autobiography ("Growing up in Vermont") and Morgan horses ("The Morgan Horse and the Vermonter – A Working Partnership").

Other materials of interest within the collection are video and audio recordings, especially those featuring interviews with Davis, made in the 1970s and 1980s. The collection also includes extensive of newspaper clippings during Davis' years as Vermont governor (1969-1972) as well as a small number of invitations and other ephemeral items related to his two terms as governor. The collection also contains photographs and correspondence between Deane and former Dartmouth College and National Life Insurance president, Ernest Martin Hopkins (1877-1964).

#### **Related Collections**

This collection is supplemented by the Deane C. Davis Papers Addendum (BHC 542-544).

The Leahy Library of the Vermont Historical Society also holds the papers of Davis' second wife, Marjorie, and her Smith ancestors for the period 1892-1991 (Doc 737-739, MSA 724, MSA 738), and a separate collection of her photographs (FB-124). The papers include some political-related material, Christmas cards, letters to both Marjorie and Deane, memorabilia, house plans, one daily planner from 1990, and some photographs. The papers also include manuscript notes on a meeting regarding American POWs with leaders from North Viet Nam that Deane and Marjorie Davis attended in Paris on June 4-5, 1971 (Doc 739:27.1). Marjorie Davis's photograph collection and an unprocessed collection of negatives include many images of Deane C. Davis.

The Leahy Library also holds the papers of Deane Davis's first wife's family, the Thomas H. Cave Family Papers (MSA 868); and the papers of his son, Thomas C. Davis (Doc 805).

Additional material from the business and political careers of Deane C. Davis are in the library's broadside, photograph, audio, video, and printed collections and in the VHS museum's collection.
