



# EUROPEAN ZONE DRAW FOR THE PRELIMINARY COMPETITION

### **Basic conditions**

- ➢ 52 members.
- ➢ 51 entries.
- ➢ Germany qualified automatically as host.
- > 13 teams to qualify plus Germany.

### **Preliminary competition**

- > 8 groups (3 groups of 7 teams and 5 groups of 6 teams).
- > League system on a home and away basis.
- > The 8 winners of each group and the 2 best  $2^{nd}$  placed teams qualify directly.
- The other 6 2<sup>nd</sup> placed teams are drawn against each other for 3 play-off matches (on home and away basis) to determine the other 3 qualifiers.

### Allocation to pots

- The 51 countries will be classified on the basis of their results in the qualifying competitions for the 2002 FIFA World Cup Korea/Japan and EURO 2004.
- > 51 teams are divided into 7 pots. Pots A to F contain 8 teams and pot G contains 3 teams.
- England, France, Italy and Spain will be drawn into 6-team groups due to the greater number of matches played as a result of having more domestic clubs involved in international club competitions.





### 51 teams in 7 pots. Pots A to F contain 8 teams and pot G contains 3 teams.

#### Draw procedure

Draw starts with pot G and ends with pot A. Each pot is entirely emptied before proceeding to the next pot. The teams are allocated in the order in which they are drawn into groups 1 to 8 starting in their respective position (see below) from left to right.


- Teams in pot G are drawn into groups 1 to 3 and placed in position 7 in each group, starting with group 1 from left to right.
- Then, the 8 teams in pot F are drawn into the 8 groups and placed in position 6 in each group, starting with group 1 from left to right.
- The same procedure applies to pots E to B taking into consideration the respective position within the respective group.
- The 8 teams in pot A are drawn into the 8 groups and placed in position 1 in each group, starting with group 1 from left to right. When England, France, Italy and Spain are drawn, they will be placed in groups 4 to 8, starting with group 4 from left to right.





## 1<sup>st</sup> Stage

8 groups (3 groups of 7 teams and 5 groups of 6 teams).

- $\succ$  The winner of each group and the 2 best 2<sup>nd</sup> placed teams qualify directly.
- To determine the 2 best 2<sup>nd</sup> placed teams, the results against the teams of the same group in 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> place will be taken into consideration.

## 2<sup>nd</sup> Stage

➤ The other 6 2<sup>nd</sup> placed teams are drawn against each other for 3 play-off matches (on home and away basis) to determine the 3 other teams that qualify for the 2006 FIFA World Cup Germany<sup>TM</sup>.
