What is the LALM

The Latin American Lutheran Mission is an independent Lutheran mission focused on proclaiming the Gospel in Mexico.



♦ It is the parent and now partner of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Mexico, training and equipping the people of Mexico to fulfill Christ's "Great Commission".

How Did This Ministry Begin?

In 1943 two Lutheran single missionaries Myrtle Nordin and Aileen Lindahl began to work in Mexico. It came to be called the Latin American Lutheran Mission. Their strategy was to train nationals through a Bible Institute to be pastors, evangelists, and leaders. These trainees were sent out with the mandate to preach and teach the Good News and the result was the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Mexico. The ELCM is the largest Lutheran presence in the country serving northeastern Mexico within a 180 mile radius of Monterrey, the third largest city in Mexico.

What is Unique About the LALM?

LALM does not send expatriate missionaries into Mexico. Rather, Mexicans are trained for leading their own congregations and missions.

Where is LALM Headquartered?

LALM has its mission border station in Laredo, Texas with housing for the directors, a guest house, Gospel Bookstore, Bethel Lutheran Church and a dormitory for groups coming through to serve the Lutheran Church of Mexico.



What are some of the Characteristics of the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Mexico?


