4KIDS ENTERTAINMENT ADDS EMMY AWARD WINNING SHOW "BACK TO THE FUTURE" TO FOX BOX LINEUP

New York, NY (March 13, 2003) – **4Kids Entertainment, Inc.** (**NYSE: KDE**) announced today that it is adding a new television series to its Saturday morning FOX BOX lineup. The new addition, Emmy award winning-series "Back To The Future," will debut on FOX BOX, Saturday, March 22 at 8:30AM (ET/PT).

"Back To The Future" stars Christopher Lloyd in live-action wrap-arounds featuring scientific demonstrations by Bill Nye, the host of "Bill Nye the Science Guy." Dan Castellaneta, the voice of Homer Simpson in "The Simpsons," lends his voice as Doc Brown. Tom Wilson and Mary Steenburgen provide their voice talent - Wilson as the show's archrival through history, Biff Tannen; and Steenburgen as Doc's no-nonsense wife, Clara Clayton Brown. The series has won several awards, including two Daytime Emmys.

"Back To The Future is an award-winning show that is based on three blockbuster films of the same title," said Al Kahn, Chairman and Chief Executive Office of 4Kids Entertainment. "The series is a perfect fit for our action-oriented Saturday morning block and it is an FCC core educational show, which helps us to meet our programming requirements for the FOX BOX."

The addition of "Back To The Future" follows the debut of the swashbuckling live action-adventure series, "Pirate Islands," on FOX BOX this past Saturday, March 8 at 11:30am (ET/PT). The show follows the adventures of the Redding kids, Kate, Nicholas and Sarah, who are thrown into the real life action and adventure of their Dad's prototype video game, Pirate Islands. Through a freakish happening, the kids get zapped into the game itself and find themselves trapped behind the video screen. The only way to get home is to beat the game!

This high-concept action-adventure series transports kids into a world ruled by eighteenth century Pirates where they are marooned on an exotic island along with a group of castaway children. Allied with the castaways, the Redding kids set up a base in a secret tree house to battle the sinister Captain Blackheart and his motley band of fearsome Pirates.

The Company noted that the two new shows join FOX BOX's existing Saturday morning line-up of kids series: "Teenage Mutant Ninja Turtles," "Kirby: Right Back At Ya!" "Fighting Foodons," "Ultimate Muscle: The Kinnikuman Legacy" and "The Cramp Twins."
