WHEREAS, Syracuse University men's basketball coach Jim Boeheim, enjoying his 26th season at the helm, looks back at a 25-season record of 600–208, or .743 percentage, ranking him fifth among active Division I coaches; and

WHEREAS, Coach Boeheim has led the team to NCAA visits in 21 campaigns, has led 11 teams to the NCAA "Sweet 16" (2 of those to the championship tilt), and has led a string of 10 consecutive NCAA tournament berths (1983-1992), the fourth-longest streak of all time; and
