

Commencement of revenue service at Changi Airport station

Singapore MRT Ltd is pleased to announce the start of revenue service to Changi Airport Station on Friday, 8 February 2002.

The new through MRT service to Changi Airport Station provides a convenient and economical way to travel between Changi Airport and the city. In less than 30 minutes, commuters can travel from Changi Airport Station to City Hall Station.

The through service between Boon Lay and Expo stations has been extended to serve Changi Airport Station. The through service, which provides a direct connection between the Changi Airport MRT Extension and the East West MRT Line, operates at an average frequency of 12 minutes.

Passengers heading to Changi Airport Station are advised to note the terminal stations (Pasir Ris or Changi Airport) displayed on the plasma screens at the station platform. As a reminder to passengers, in-train announcements will also be made from Kembangan Station onwards for trains headed for Changi Airport Station.

The first and last train timings at Changi Airport Station are as follows:

For passengers' convenience, the 12 trains deployed on the through service are retrofitted with luggage racks and have free spaces next to the doorways. Passengers are advised to note that luggage brought into the train should not exceed 81 cm \times 58 cm \times 30 cm.

To complement the Changi Airport - Boon Lay trains, another nine trains serving the North South and East West lines will have free space near one pair of train doors per train car.

Fares are according to the current MRT fare structure i.e. calculated based on distance. For example, the fares from Changi Airport Station to City Hall Station will be \$1.40 for single trip ticket and \$1.35 for farecard.
