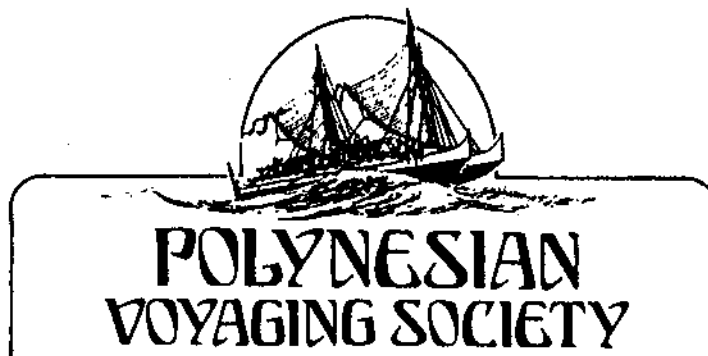

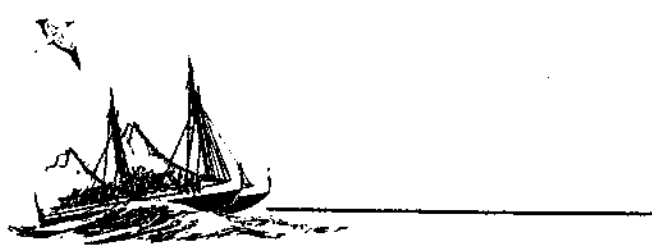

Introduction

The Polynesian Voyaging Society, which built the HOKULE'A, was organized in Hawaii in 1973 by three men:

Herb Kawainui Kane, artist and designer, interested in Polynesian history and canoe design

Ben Finney, University of Hawaii anthropology professor and scholar, interested in the early settling of the Pacific Islands

Tommy Holmes, Pacific history scholar, interested in the canoes of Polynesia

All three shared background in the history of Pacific migrations and canoe design. Kane wrote on the subject for the National Geographic Society. Finney designed and built a canoe replica which he sailed. He had also written and published his research on ancient navigation and Polynesian migration theories. Holmes conducted his own research on canoe design and published a book on the subject.

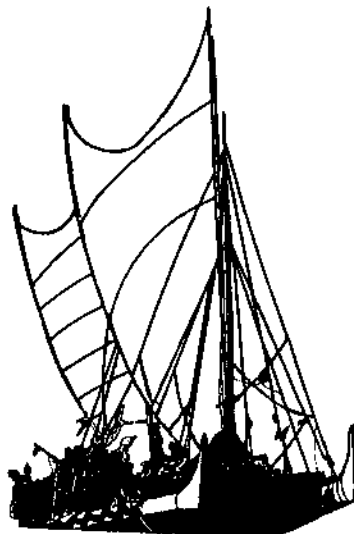
In 1974 they designed and built the double hulled canoe HOKULE'A which was launched in 1975. In 1976 the canoe sailed to Tahiti with a mostly local crew, navigated without instruments by Mau Piailug from the Micronesian Island of Satawal. Mau left the voyage in Tahiti but returned to Hawaii in later years to help train others in his traditional methods of navigation and accompanied the HOKULE'A on subsequent voyages as advisor.

Joining the 1976 crew in Tahiti for the return trip was Nainoa Thompson, then in his early 20's. Nainoa became engrossed in non-instrument navigation and spent the next three years studying the stars at Bishop Museum Planetarium. In addition he was tutored by Mau in the ancient art of Wayfinding. In 1980 Thompson successfully navigated HOKULE'A to Tahiti and back. He was to repeat and expand this accomplishment in the 1985-87 Voyage of Rediscovery which included New Zealand, Samoa, Tonga and the Cook Islands as well as Tahiti.

The building and sailing of HOKULE'A, by the Society helped spark the renewed interest in Hawaiian/Polynesian cultural heritage and language which came to be regarded as the "Hawaiian Renaissance" of the 1970's. Today HOKULE'A is considered the dominant cultural symbol, not only in Hawaii but throughout Oceania.

Using the Guide

The material has been sorted into three distinct chronological groups to indicate the three major voyages of the HOKULE'A. A fourth or sub-group; Group D (one drawer only), includes material generated by Children's book project which overlaps groups A and B. Each group has a separate inventory; however, the index which follows the inventories includes all four groups.

Group A, 1973 - 1976, organizing the Polynesian Voyaging Society, building the HOKULE'A and the 1976 voyage to Tahiti. code green

Group B, 1977 - 1983, expanding the educational function, inter-island sailing and the training of Nainoa Thompson as non-instrumental navigator. Includes the 1980 voyage to Tahiti. code blue

Group C, 1984 - 1988 planning & executing the two year Voyage of Rediscovery. code red

Group D, Children's Book Project 1974 - 1983 code yellow

Finding material in the inventories. An inventory is a running listing of the files in the order they appear in the drawers; example:

C indicates group 4 drawer number 6 file number title of the file

Using the index. Entries are alphabetical by file and folder titles, proper names and subject headings; example:

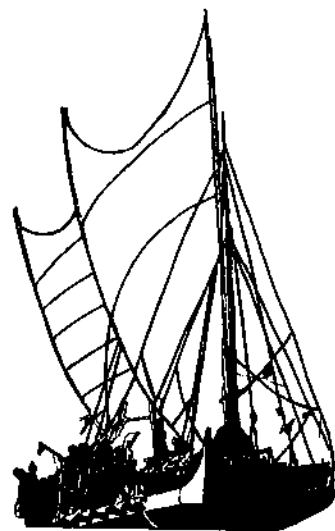

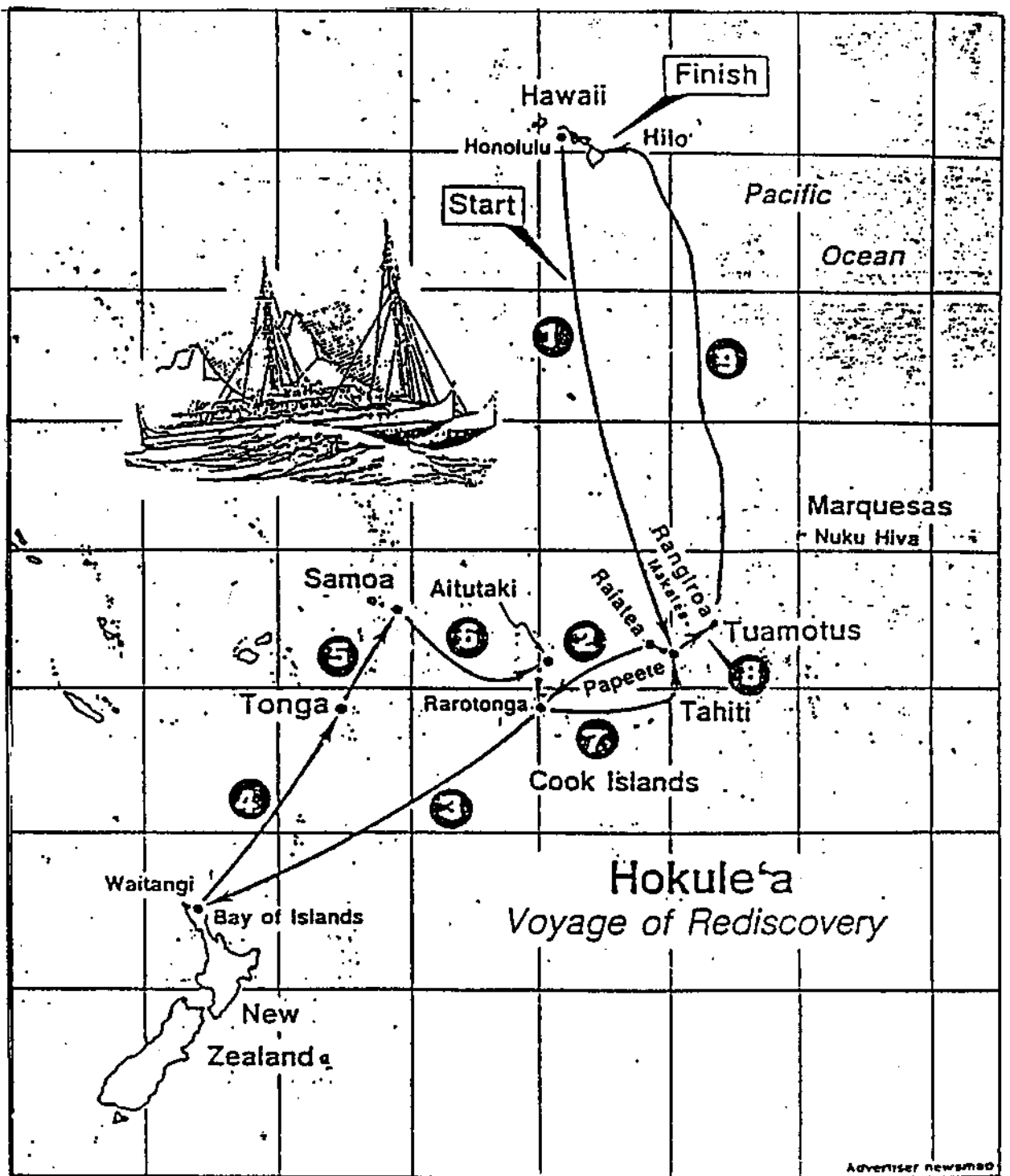
