Notes

The 2007/2008 ranking list will be calculated using points earned over the two seasons 2006/2007 and 2007/2008.

Players losing their first round match will receive points detailed in the rows marked 'seeded loser'.

Players who have joined The Tour commencing the 2007/2008 season will receive starter points equivalent to the 8th player qualifying from the 1 year list. Players on The Tour who have earned points in the 2006/2007 season will retain the points earned and will not be allocated any other points (even if they are less than the starter points allocated).

Players on equal points at the end of the season will be ranked according to most points earned in the last season. Should this not determine positions, points in events working backwards from the World Championship will be considered.

Finally, if still equal, frames won in losing final match would be used from events working backwards from the World Championship.
