RESOLUTION M 12. 01 (CD 1073-2.3, OCR-B)

WG 3 approves the disposition of comments report prepared by the project editor and recommends to SC 2 that this project be changed to Type 2 Technical Report. The project editor is requested to prepare for the production of a revised text for further processing that includes an explanatory text for the change.

RESOLUTION M 12.02 (Revision of ISO/IEC 6429: 1992, Control Functions for coded character sets)
