Professional Career

- In 2005, competed in seven events before fatigue and system illness forced her to take the second half of the season off.
- In 2004, suffered nerve damage to her foot and was forced to take the second half of the season off.
- In 2003, best finish was a tie for seventh at the Chick-fil-A Charity Championship hosted by Nancy Lopez.
- In 2002, best finish was a tie for seventh at the Wendy's Championship for Children at Tartan Fields.
- In 2001, best finish was a tie for fifth at the Williams Championship; recorded her third LPGA career hole-in-one during the second round of the Standard Register PING.
- In 2000, posted a season-best seventh place at the AFLAC Champions Presented by Southern Living, where she crossed the \$2 million mark in career earnings.
- In 1999, posted a career-low 62 during the second round of the Chick-fil-A Charity Championship, where she tied for sixth.
- In 1998, captured her fifth career victory at the Sara Lee Classic after winning a sudden-death playoff with Nancy Lopez, Donna Andrews and Jenny Lidback.
- In 1997, totaled seven top 10s, including a season-best third-place finish at the Chrysler-Plymouth Tournament of Champions.
- In 1996, captured her fourth career victory at the Chick-fil-A Charity Championship; crossed the \$1 million mark in career earnings at the McDonald's LPGA Championship.
- In 1995, made her second LPGA career hole-in-one in the first round of the Chrysler-Plymouth Tournament of Champions; top finish was a tie for second at the LPGA Corning Classic.
- In 1994, captured her third career victory at the State Farm Rail Classic.
- In 1993, best finish was a tie for sixth at the PING-Cellular One LPGA Golf Championship.
- In 1992, despite suffering from tendonitis during half of the season, totaled 12 top-20 finishes and won the Oldsmobile Classic.
- In 1991, carded her first LPGA career hole-in-one during the third round of the U.S. Women's Open; best finish was a tie for fourth at the Lady Keystone Open.
- In 1990, became a Rolex First-Time Winner at the Boston Five Classic, where she defeated Lenore Rittenhouse in a sudden-death playoff.
- In 1989, best finish was a tie for fifth at the Chrysler-Plymouth Classic.
- In 1988, returned to the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament, where she tied for 29th to earn non-exempt status for the 1989 LPGA season.
- In 1987, best finish was a tie for 21st at the S&H Golf Classic, her first event as an LPGA professional; did not retain her card for the 1988 LPGA season.
- In 1986, qualified for the Tour by tying for 46th at the LPGA Final Qualifying Tournament to earn non-exempt status for the 1987 LPGA season.
- Prior to joining the LPGA Tour, won six times on the Futures Tour.

Amateur

Mucha was a semifinalist at the 1984 Women's Trans-National. That same year, she received All-American honorable mention honors while playing for Michigan State University, where she captured two collegiate titles: the Illinois State Invitational and the Ohio State Invitational.
