## Claim 5874

NR 168.5 claims...

...lots seaward at Kaawaloa [Kona, Hawaii]: Hanapahoehoe, Awili, Kalaemamo, Haliilua.

...lots inland of Kaawaloa: Kukuipuha, Keopu, Paohia.

...lots seaward at Kealakekua: Kauhala, Hikiau, Wailokoaii, Weuweu, Papahola

...at Lahaina: Puamana, Lihiopuanaana [sic; lihi of Puamana]

...at Paeohia I have some lots

...in Honolulu: Manaaiole and some others [Note in margin says "missed--not copied"]

NT 80.10 December 17, 1851 Z. Kaauwai, sworn: I know her pahale at Honolulu, Manaaiole its name; 7 houses stand there. Bounded mauka, vacant kula land; Waikiki, land purchased by Kapaakea and pahale of Kuhia [K/A; LCA 656]; makai, pahale of Kaiahua [LCA 1818 at Punchbowl & Beretania]; Ewa, Pauoa road and kula.

She received the parcel Manaluna from [her father] Aikanaka in 1837, and the parcel Manalalo came to her husband Kapaakea from Kamanawa. She occupies it without dispute.

Kaneakalani, sworn: I know her **pahale at Honolulu** that is bounded mauka, by the pa of the King, Pelekane its name; Waikiki, road to the seashore [?]; makai, Beretania St., Ewa, pa of Huevo [LCA 776]. She received this pa from [her father] Aikanaka and no one disputes it.

NT 359.10 "contd. from NT 80.10" April 28, 1854:

Moehonua witness to **Puamana**: Recd. from kupuna.

Kekai witness to 1 loi and kula in Pahoa: Recd. from [her grandmother] Keohohiwa in 1834 or 1835.

FT 359.10 (in Hawaiian) April 28, 1854

Moehonua witness to

1) **pahale at Puamana, Lahaina, Maui**; received from her "several grandparents" (mau kupuna)

2) 1 taro pondfield and kula at Pahoa, Lahaina; received from her grandmother Keohohiwa in 1834 or 1835. Keawe, sworn, confirms.

(RP 709) Punchbowl St. [sic], Honolulu 9.57 acres [sic. This **pahale** shows on Greer map mauka of Beretania St. at Alakea but is not listed. Seems to be confused with Manaluna & lalo, see below]

In FT 325.3 report of the Committee "to make an equitable division of the houselots belonging to the chiefs situated in Honolulu between said chiefs and the government....Keohokalole and Kapaakea have 3 lots; recommend Royal Patents in fee simple be granted without division, they first conveying to the government the ahupuaa of Kealakekua 4 in the district of Kula, Maui [sic; Kealahou 4, Kula, Maui in "Received" list]

NT 80.10 December 17, 1851 Z. Kaauwai witness to her houselot "Manaaiole" in Honolulu. Received from [father] Aikanaka in 1837. Kaneakalau witness to house "in Honolulu"

NT 326.10 Kaia witness to kula and kalo land in Kapiwai [Pauoa, Kona, Oahu]. Recd. from Keino in Kaahumanu's lifetime. I live there under [K/A] Kapaakea [Keohokalole's husband]

Member of the House of Nobles 1841-1847; member of the Privy Council 1846-1847.

Her tomb at Kawaiahao was built by "Mr. Hulipahu" [alias Linton Torbert] at a cost of \$500.00 (*Kuokoa*, April 24, 1869 p 2 c 5)

PROBATE 1839 (1st CC); joint number with her husband K/A Kapaakea

At the time of death on April 6, 1869, her debts were \$1600.00. Her executor John Dominis receives Court permission to sell:

- Honohina, ahp. Hilo, Hawaii (sold to Richard K. Stanley)
- Kawela, ahp., Kau, Hawaii (sold to Frank W. Harris)

[At end of Probate file is listing apportioning remaining lands to her heirs [her children] and their spouses: Lydia and John Dominis; Likelike, w. [not married to A. Cleghorn until the next year]; Kalakaua and Kapiolani; W.P. Kalahoolewa (Wm. Pitt Leleiohoku, a minor, to his guardian, Ruth Keelikolani)]

Kekuanaoa's testimony in Equity 220 (p. 72):

... "Keohokalole received all the property of Naihe and Aikanaka."

[i.e., the lands inherited from Kameeiamoku and Keawe-a-Heulu, Kamehameha's warrior chiefs and counsellors, which accounts for her extensive holdings at Mahele time]
