## **New Main Street Parking Garage to be Dedicated Monday**

Officials from the City of Dayton and the Dayton/Montgomery County Port Authority will join other community partners in dedicating downtown newest parking garage on Monday, November 10 at 10:00 a.m. The facility will officially be open for public use on Tuesday.

The new Main Street Parking Garage is located on the west side of Main Street between First Street and Monument Avenue. The dedication ceremony will take place inside the garage's

Main Street entrance, near the Private Fair monument.

The new seven-floor parking garage will accommodate 1,200 vehicles. Spaces will be available for monthly customers as well as daily or hourly parkers. The facility represents an investment downtown of approximately \$20 million.

"We are excited about opening the new Main Street Parking Garage to help serve the thousands of people who work, visit or live downtown," Mayor Rhine McLin said. "As downtown evolves to meet the needs of new business, entertainment and residential customers, parking becomes an increasingly important element. In

addition to serving the hundreds of employees who will occupy the new CareSource headquarters building on Main Street, this new parking garage will also meet the demand of motorists coming downtown to dine, attend a show or conduct business."

Ron Parker, President of the Dayton-Montgomery County Port Authority, said, "The Port is pleased we could partner with the City of Dayton to build and operate this important asset for downtown."

The Main Street Parking Garage is scheduled to be open to customers in phases. Employees of CareSource, which has contracted to use the facility, will begin occupying the new garage in incremental steps over the next week.
