10km/6 miles

MOLE GAP TRAIL

Discover the beautiful Surrey Hills following the silver arrow trail. Start and finish in 2 picturesque market towns, and enjoy plenty of fine Surrey views as well as Denbies vineyard en route.

The walk

START - Exit Leatherhead station via Platform 2. turn R onto footpath. Follow to main (Randalls) rd, cross road and enter park. Take the diagonal path through park up to next (Station) road. Cross road and turn L uphill. Bear R towards town centre, passing War Memorial on L and continuing down R towards river, passing the Running Horse pub on R.

- 1. GR TQ 164563 Cross road next to mini roundabout towards arched Town Bridge. Walk over bridge. Turn L immediately and follow path along River Mole. Keep straight on footpath (lookout for Shell Bridge).
- 2. GR TQ 166559 At end of footpath, turn R onto tarmac drive. Continue down drive passing Thorncroft Manor. Before reaching Thorncroft vineyard, turn L onto path and go through metal kissing gate. Follow path onwards along the riverside, through another kissing gate, Young Street underpass and a further kissing gate. Enter Norbury Park. Walk across field and bear R uphill to join track. Go through kissing gate. At cottage, turn R uphill through kissing gate then under railway bridge.

- 4. GR TQ 162529 After bridge, continue on track then turn R past cottage. Continue ahead through 3 kissing gates and over River Mole footbridge. Follow ahead through kissing gate into Westhumble with St Michael's chapel and Arch on
- 5. GR TQ 167519 Cross Chapel Lane and turn R along footpath. Continue along footpath where it separates from road, then continue a further 25m along Chapel Lane. Turn L down narrow path between fences and hedges. Continue ahead crossing road, through kissing gate into field. Go through field and kissing gate to stone track - North Downs Way. Continue through gate and enter vineyard. Keep ahead on track crossing drive to Denbies Vineyard. When main track turns right, keep ahead on grassy track. Go through metal kissing gate and ahead uphill.
- 6. 6. GR TQ 163503 At path junction, turn L along track. Follow track to road. Just before road, bear L along narrow path and through kissing gate to next road. Cross road and keep ahead on path then turn R along Chichester Road. At end of road follow the footpath to R beside dual carriageway. Keep straight, crossing 3 side roads to subway. Go through subway, exiting at Dorking Station.
