# GOVERNMENT OF TRIPURA DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE ANNUAL PLAN: 2011-12

#### Introduction:

Tripura is one of the seven states in the north eastern part of India located between 22 degree and 56 minutes and 24 degree and 32 minutes north latitude and between 90 degree and 09 minutes and 92 degree and 20 minutes east latitude. A total geographical area of 10491 Sq. Kilometer comprising of four districts viz. North Tripura, South Tripura, West Tripura and Dhalai. There is a common belief that the name of the State has originated from "Tripura Sundari" - the presiding deity of the land which is famous as one of the 51 pethos of Hindu Pilgrims.

#### **Population Statistics:**

Population Census Data of Tripura during 2011 shows that it has total population of 36.71 Lakh which is approximately 0.30% of total Indian Population. Literacy rate in Tripura has seen upward trend and is 87.75% as per 2011 population census. Of that, male literacy stands at 92.18% while female literacy is at 83.15%.

#### Land, Soil & Climate:

The State of Tripura enjoys a typical monsoon climate with variations ranging from Sub-tropical to temperate conditions in hilly areas. The climate of Tripura exhibits a strong seasonal rhythm; the year being divisible into four characteristic seasons, viz. (i) Winter (December- February) (ii) Pre-monsoon (March-April) (iii) Monsoon (May – September) and (iv) Post Monsoon (October-November). The monsoon period lasting for about 5 months from may to September in the longest season of the State. The amount of total annual rainfall in the State varies between 1500 mm. to 2500 mm. The maximum and minimum temperatures during Winter are 27°C and 13°C and during Summer are 35°C and 24°C respectively.

#### Land classification:

According to classification of terrain, the land of this State is divided into 5(five) major groups, which are reflected in the following table:

#### **Fertility Status of Soil:**

The pH values of Tripura Soils vary from 4.05 to 6.05 and in more than 90 percent of the Soils of Tripura pH is below 5.6. On an average 52.1 percent of soils are medium, 22.5 percent soils are low and 25.4% soils are high in organic carbon content. About 60.5 percent soils are deficient in phosphorous, 26.9 percent soils are medium and 12.6 percent are high in available phosphorous content. Low available phosphorous content is related to strongly acidic soil condition. In the State as a whole 67.3 percent of the Soils are low, 24.7 percent soils are medium and 8 percent soils are high in available potash content. Shifting cultivation prevalent in the region is responsible for removal of most fertile top soils from hill slopes.

#### **Operational Holdings:**

Fragmentation of land holding is continuing as a part of social phenomenon. Average size of holding has declined from 1.25 hectares in 1976-77 to 0.56 hectare and this is the lowest amongst other seven sister state of NE Region.

#### **Category – wise Area Operated: Tripura:**

Small and Marginal farmers constitute 95% of total holding while the area occupied by them is only 74%. Marginal farming promotes traditional system of cultivation and this is a major constraint in adoption of modern technology.

#### **Crop Scenario:**

Paddy is the major crop in this State and contributes about 98% of the total food grain production. Beside this, wheat, maize, pulses, oilseeds, potato, vegetables, different fruits & plantation crops, tea and rubber cover rest of the cultivable area in the State. The following table is elucidative of the existing crop distribution pattern of the state (2009-10\*).

The Perspective Plan for achieving self-sufficiency in foodgrains started in 2000-01 were reviewed on 7th December, 2009. It was decided that the period of Perspective Plan could be considered for extension by 2 more years i.e. up to 2011-12. An exercise at the block level has also been carried out to identify the revised strategies for increasing foodgrains production in the state. Block-level Action Plan for 2010-11 and 2011-12 has been prepared based on the farmers' views received in the consultation meetings held with the farmers of 40 blocks during the period from 5th January to 27th January, 2010 and the past experiences of the field level agricultural extension workers, officers at Agricultural Sub-divisions, Districts and the Directorate including the scientists of ICAR.

To increase the production level of food grains up to 8.62 lakh tons to attain the self-sufficiency by 2012, following strategies have been adopted:

- i. Increasing production through area expansion, and
- ii. Increasing production through productivity enhancement.

#### i. <u>Increasing production through Area Expansion approach</u>:

**Aush Paddy (Autumn Paddy):** An additional **14,526** hectares area will be brought under Aush Paddy during 2011-12.

**Boro Paddy (Summer Paddy):** Boro Paddy area will be increased by 10,039 hectares by 2011-12. Boro Paddy area target would be increased to 72,445 hectares in 2011-12 from the normal level of 62,406 hectares.

**Hybrid Paddy:** Hybrid paddy cultivation is targeted to be increased to 10,330 hectares in 2011-12 for which the farmer will be given assistance @ 50% hybrid paddy seed cost.

**Hybrid Maize:** Maize cultivation would be increased to 5,000 hectares in 2011-12 from the normal of 2352 hectares. The additional area of 2648 hectares in 2011-12 is proposed to be cultivated in plain land situation with hybrid seeds for which assistance as 50% cost of hybrid seeds may be given to the farmers.

**Pluses:** Cultivation of pulse crops is to be increased to 12,500 hectares in 2011-12 from the normal of 7,385 hectares. An additional area of 5,115 hectares in 2011-12 has been proposed to be covered mainly by Arhar, Blackgram, Moong, Lentil and Pea.

**Oilseeds:** Cultivation of oilseeds will be increased to 10,000 hectares in 2011-12 from the normal of 4,100 hectares. Farmers are to be encouraged in increasing area under Rape and mustard, Sesamum and Ground nut crops.

#### ii. Increasing production through Productivity approach:

**100% seed treatment**: Seed carries fungi, bacteria, and viruses on the seed coat or within the seed, some of which cause plant diseases. Treating seed with pesticides to protect it from pests that attack seed and seedlings can improve stand quality, increase yields, and increase return on investment. Seed treatments have played and are still playing a significant role in improving the establishment of healthy crops leading to 10-15% more yields. 100% seed treatment has to be popularized for which seed treating chemicals would be given to the farmers at free of cost.

**Varietal replacement**: Varietal replacement of all major crops with recently released high yielding varieties with resistance or tolerance to biotic and abiotic stress is to be continued in the year also. Short duration high yielding varieties suitable to agro-climatic situation are to be popularized to accommodate 300% cropping intensity wherever feasible in irrigated situation.

**Seed replacement**: Supply of new crop varieties in the form of certified seed distribution is to be taken up to provide options to the farmers for selection of appropriate cultivars for their farms. Optimum level of seed replacement rate (33% for paddy) already achieved and being maintained the same for last couple of years. But, it is also experienced that resource poor farmers are not replacing their degenerated seeds regularly, which affects overall production and productivity. In view of the above, it is necessary to list out village-wise those resource-poor farmers and special attention is to be given targeting them to convince for seed replacement. Crop-wise targets for seed replacement rates (SRR) are to be as under:

- (i) Paddy 33%,
- (ii) Maize-50%,
- (iii) Pulses-50%
- (iv) Oilseeds- 50%, and
- (**v**) Hybrids-100%.

HYV certified seed production: With the introduction of Perspective Plan, special initiatives were taken to make the state self-sufficient in respect of HYV seeds. The state is now producing surplus of HYV paddy and mustard seeds. Seed production of five pulse crops namely Arhar, Moong (Green gram), Black gram, Lentil and Field Pea has been started in the Registered Seed Growers' field under the technical supervision of the State Seed Certification Agency. The endeavour of the Agriculture department would continue through Registered Seed Growers Programme to facilitate adequate and timely supply of quality certified HYV seeds of paddy, pulses and oilseeds to the farmers.

**Application of lime and micronutrients**: According to the survey conducted by the National Bureau of Soil Survey and Land Use Planning (NBSS & LUP, ICAR), 92% of the total rice based cropping system areas of Tripura falls under the category of extremely acidic to strongly acidic category. Application of lime as amendment to neutralize the acid soils to a certain extent had been found effective. But farmers found the complete reclamation with lime to

desired level is very expensive. Therefore, amelioration of acid soils with minimum amount of lime with balanced application of all deficient nutrients including micronutrients is required to be popularized amongst the farmers. Therefore, it is proposed that farmers may be encouraged by way of providing 50% subsidy to use of soil ameliorants (liming) and micronutrients (like Zinc, Boron) especially in the rice-based cropping system for management of soil health fertility and increasing the production as well.

Integrated Nutrient Management: Balanced and optimum use of fertilizers is proposed to be promoted together with use of organic manures & bio-fertilizers to optimize the efficiency of nutrient use. Farmers will be given training to ensure judicious use of fertilizers in a particular season for a particular crop, use of bio-fertilizers as a supplementation of the chemical fertilizers to reduce the cost of cultivation and minimize the crisis of availability of chemical fertilizers, etc. Soil testing and quality testing of fertilizers are proposed to be ensured and supply of spurious inputs will be checked. Moreover, popularization of Integrated Nutrient Management (INM) or Integrated Plant Nutrient Supply (IPNS) is essential to increase the production in a sustainable manner.

**Integrated Pest Management:** The concept of Bio-Intensive Pest Management (BIPM) shall be popularized. Integrated pest management and use of biotic agents in order to minimize the indiscriminate and injudicious use of chemical pesticides will be the cardinal principle covering plant protection. BIPM approach is found to be more efficient, cost effective and ecofriendly especially in controlling diseases of different agriculture, horticulture and vegetable crops.

**Farm Mechanization:** Selective and eco-friendly farm mechanization through appropriate technology is to be promoted, with special reference to rainfed farming to reduce arduous work and to make agriculture efficient and competitive as also to increase crop productivity. Individual farmer will be given assisted by providing subsidy on cost of farm implements/machinery convergence of funds from Macro management of Agriculture and R.K.V.Y.

Farmers' Training: The farmers' training programmes are organized at Gram Panchayat and Agriculture Sector level. Targeted farmers would be given training on the specific crop/technology. Trainee farmers would be selected in such a manner that no duplication of beneficiary for next training is made. Farm Schools, Farmers' Field Schools and similar other training programmes of ATMA, Macro Management in Agriculture shall be implemented in a more effective manner. Special thrust would be given on farmers' training for 100% seed treatment, training on hybrid techniques, cultivation of Maize in plain lands, growing more area under aus paddy, following 300% cropping sequence under irrigated condition, application of lime and micro-nutrients etc. so that targeted production is achieved by 2011-12.

**Agricultural Extension:** The research and extension linkages will be strengthened to improve quality and effectiveness of research and extension system. The extension system will be broad based and revitalized. Innovative and decentralized institutional changes will be introduced to make the extension system farmer-responsible and farmer-accountable. Role of

Krishi Vigyan Kendras (KVKs), Farmers Groups and para-technicians in agricultural extension will be encouraged for organizing demand driven production systems. Development of human resources through capacity building and skill upgradation of public extension functionaries and other extension functionaries will be accorded a high priority.

**Agricultural Marketing facilities:** Emphasis will be laid on development of marketing infrastructure and techniques of preservation, storage and transportation with a view to reducing post-harvest losses and ensuring a better return to the grower. The weekly periodic markets will be upgraded and strengthened. Producers markets on the lines of *Raytu Bazars* will be encouraged. Storage facilities for different kinds of agricultural products will be created in the production areas or nearby places particularly in the rural areas so that the farmers can transport their produce to these places immediately after harvest in shortest possible time. The establishment of cold chains, provision of pre cooling facilities to farmers as a service and cold storage in the terminal markets and improving the retail marketing arrangements in urban areas will be given priority. Up-gradation and dissemination of market intelligence will receive particular attention.

**Agricultural Credit:** Progressive institutionalization of rural and farm credit will be continued for providing timely and adequate credit to farmers. Field level officials of Agriculture Department shall take special initiatives to facilitate more credit flow to agriculture sector through Kisan Credit Card (KCC) and other programmes available in the Financial Institutes.

**Chemical fertilizers:** Agriculture Department would make availability of 50% of required chemical fertilizers throughout the state. Balance 50% of required chemical fertilizers will be arranged by the private dealers.

**Buffer stock of fertilizers:** Requirement of chemical fertilizers for 2011-12 has been estimated to the level of 1,20,500 tons. The entire quantity of fertilizers is required to be brought from the outside states. It was experienced in the past that farmers did not get fertilizers as per their need and time mainly due to frequent disruption in railway transport system and other bottlenecks in getting fertilizers, which hampered the total production. Private dealers are not in a position to bring adequate quantity of fertilizers for creating buffer stock in the state. The Agriculture department will take all possible initiatives to create buffer stock of one season's requirement of different fertilizers in advance.

#### FOREST RIGHT ACT (FRA, 2006):

The Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 was passed in the parliament, on 13 December 2006. The President of India assented to the Bill on 29 December 2006 and the Act came into force.

Under the provision of the Act, the Govt. of Tripura has already identified 1.17 lakhs Tribal families and allotted 1.78 lakhs hectare of land among them. A large part of this area shall add to the existing 2.55 lakhs hectare cultivable area of the state.

On the basis of reconnaissance survey of area under Forest Dwellers Act, 2006 it has been estimated that nearly 15-20% and 25-30 % area can be brought under sustainable and eco-friendly use for Agricultural crops, Vegetable and other Horti-plantation crops respectively. Presently most of these lands are being utilized for subsistence of the livelihood of several ethnic groups of tribal population. The traditional practice of shifting cultivation (jhum) is being followed by them. The area distributed /allotted among the tribal farmers under the Act can broadly be categorized as Rain-fed Upland ecosystem.

#### Initiatives:

To provide sustainable livelihood opportunities to the forest dwellers while retaining their symbiotic relationship with the Forest and ensuring their socio-economic development as well as retaining the ecological balance, about 25,000 hectares of additional area would be brought under Agricultural crops over a period of three years.

Some effective inter-cropping in rice based cropping system suggested in FRA areas are the following:

- ➤ Rice + Maize
- Rice + Cowpea
- > Rice + Peanut
- Rice + Seasmum
- Rice + Mungbean
- > Rice + Pigeonpea
- Maize + Pigeonpea
- Maize + Cowpea

#### **MAJOR ACHIEVEMENTS: 2010-11:**

Area Expansion: During 2010-11 area under Aush Paddy has been increased to 32930 ha
from the last year's level of 21289 ha. Maize area has also been increased to 3100 ha. from
the last year's level of 2018 ha. Similarly, area under Pulses and Oilseeds has also been
increased to 7500 ha and 4350 ha from the last year's level of 6130 ha and 3450 ha
respectively.

- **Seed Replacement:-** The optimum seed replacement rate of 33% per annum for paddy was achieved and also continued in 2010-11 also.
- **System of Rice Intensification:** The area under SRI has increased significantly. About 73,662 hectares area have been covered during 2010-11 against the last year's actual of 59577 ha.
- Seed production and certification programme: Production of certified HYV Paddy and mustard seeds again exceeded our requirement to permit export to other states through NSC to meet their requirement.
- Chemical Fertilizer: There is a perennial shortage of chemical fertilizer in the State that depends on supply from outside as there is no Fertilizer Industry in Tripura. However, due to constant persuasions and efforts made by the Agriculture department availability of chemical fertilizers has been increased during 2010-11 and the usage around 44 kg/ha. against the last year's actual of 39 kg/ha.
- **Production and use of Bio-fertilizer** is expected to increase to 2118 tons in the year 2010-11 by bringing three district level bio-fertilizer production centers through PPP mode. A large bio-fertilizer production plant with 600 metric ton capacity has also been established in the private sector and construction of ten more mini bio-fertilizer production units are nearing completion.
- Small Bore Mini Deep Tube well: With a view to increase rice based cropping intensity by bringing more area under irrigation 221 nos. Small Bore Mini Deep Tube wells have been installed during 2010-11. Besides, the Department proposes to take up more shallow tube wells under RKVY during 2011-12.
- **Farm Mechanization**: Special emphasis has been given for farm mechanization to enable the farmers to cope up with the limited time available for ploughing activities between two seasons.

#### A. STATE PLAN SCHEME:

### 1. Name of the Scheme: Agriculture Development.

#### **Objective:**

The scheme aims at to distribute certified seeds of promising varieties of Paddy, Wheat, Pulses, & Oilseeds etc to the cultivators at subsidized rate as incentive for motivation and varietal replacements, which have degenerated due to continuous use to achieve optimum level of yield.

Another objective is to popularize use of chemical fertilizers at subsidized rate (including internal transport subsidies) in conjunction with bio-fertilizer, creation of awareness for using more and more organic manure's, organizing soil testing at the farmers' doorstep etc.

The scheme also aims at providing need based support to the cultivators to combat epidemic outbreak and attack of pests and diseases. Participation in different Agri. Sub-Division & State level fairs and melas is also one of the prime focuses of the scheme.

Beside this, the scheme also aims at meeting the liabilities including salary of staff, wages of labourers, stipend, scholarship etc including cost of fuel, purchase of new vehicles, electricity and telephone charges, office expenses etc.

#### **Outlay of the Scheme:**

Rs. 14659.04 Lakhs including State share of CSS and RKVY. Out of which salary component is Rs. 382.32 including salary of Rs. 51.80 lakhs for the staff transferred to TTAADC. Non-salary component is Rs. 14276.72 lakhs including transfer of fund of Rs. 349.96 lakhs to TTAADC (Rs. 200.00 lakhs from State Plan Non-salary and Rs. 149.96 lakhs from RKVY.

#### 1. Construction of 1000 MT capacities Multi-Chambered Cold

**Store at Satchand:** In Tripura Cold Storage facilities are quite inadequate considering the requirement in the perspective of production of perishable crops like Potato, Fruits and other Vegetables. Out of which Potato is an important vegetable is required to be stored in the Cold Storage. It is expected that both coverage and production of Potato would increase largely in the coming years with introduction of True Potato Seed (TPS). Due to lack of storage facilities the farmers during the peak season, sometimes compelled to sell their produce at a throw away price. For the interest of farming community as well as to boost up the production of Potato, Vegetables, Fruits and live stock materials, it is proposed to construct 1000 MT capacity multi-chambered cold storage at Satchand. Proposed State share for 2011-12 is Rs.4.77 Lakhs.
