

NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION CENTRE NO. 2 VETERANS MEMORIAL PARKWAY INTERCHANGE CLASS ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT AND CONCURRENT NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO AMEND THE OFFICIAL PLAN & ZONING BY-LAW

The City of London is undertaking a Class Environmental Assessment Study to identify interchange locations along the entire length of the Veteran's Memorial Parkway (formerly Airport Road) corridor that best meets the functional requirements of the corridor at build-out (maximum development condition). The study area is identified on the map below. The Municipal Council for the City of London is also considering future amendments to the City's Official Plan and Zoning By-law that will assist in implementing the preferred functional design of the corridor at build out. The anticipated changes to the Official Plan and Zoning By-law include identifying new proposed interchange sites along the Veterans Memorial Parkway corridor in the Official Plan and developing policies relating to development along the corridor (adjacent to any parallel street or corridor under consideration) and possibly placing limits on development within these areas that is considered not to be consistent with the preferred functional design of the corridor. The purpose of this zoning change is to add new holding provisions and regulations to limit development in those areas that are not consistent with the preferred functional design of the corridor to build-out.

This project is being planned as a Schedule C project under the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment process so that the intent and requirements of both the *Planning Act* and *Environmental Assessment Act* are met through a co-ordinated planning and approvals process.

We are notifying you of the second Public Information Centre (PIC No. 2) and we encourage you to attend and to provide us with your comments. The purpose of PIC No. 2 is to present the alternative corridor concepts, the screening analysis of the alternatives, the preferred design concept for the corridor, and to obtain input and comments from interested persons and agencies.

The PIC No. 2 will be an Open House format and held as follows:

Following the PIC No. 2, additional comments and input will be received until December 13, 2007 regarding the preferred design concept. Subject to comments received from the PIC, the City intends to proceed with finalizing a report outlining the preferred future road design for the Veterans Memorial Parkway corridor which will be the basis for future amendments to the City's Official Plan and Zoning By-Law. The final report will be presented at a future joint public meeting of the Environment and Transportation Committee and the Planning Committee.
