



Tá gliondar croí orainn tú a chur leis an fhéile anseo i gcroí-lár Cheathrú Gheltachta Bhéal Feirste, i gcuideachta ár gairde ó Choláiste Ollscoile Naoimh Muire, Ó Chumann Cultúrtha Naoimh Gall agus ó Acadamh na hUltaise. Le linn Ré Órga na hÉireann, nuair a bhí Impireacht na Róimhe ag titim as a chéile agus an Eoraip fágtha faoi Ré Dhorcha, chuaigh Naoimh agus Scoláirí Éireannacha go dtí an Bhreatain agus go dtí an Mór-Roinn, ag bunú pobail, mainistir agus leabharlanna san Ghaill, sa Ghearmáin agus san Iodáil.

D'fhág siad cuntas scríofa, lámhscríbhinní dhathmhaisithe, croise ornáideacha, ealaín agus lámhadhéantúsáin saibhre ina ndiaidh. Shocraigh na daoine, a chuaigh na Naoimh agus Scoláirí i bhfeidhm orthu agus a fuair oiliúint dá bharr, shocraigh cuid acu dul ar ais go hÉirinn agus tuilleadh staidéir a dhéanamh ann, sa chaoi is gur lean leagáid chultúrtha na céad mhanach ag ascnamh agus ag dul chun cinn i bhfad tar éis dóibh féin bheith imithe ar slí na bhFírinne.

Thay hae leed behin scrievit raicords, han-illuminit buiks an weel-bedeckt Celtick crosses, airt an creftwark. Aften yins thay hae wrocht oan an eddycatit chaise tae gang, turn aboot, bak tae Airlan fer thair ain buiklernin, wi the ootcome at the culter an buiklair the first munks leed behin haes kep oan stravaigin an growein lang efter thay're a deid.

Yin o thaе munks, a compeir o the far-kent Columbanus, was Saunt Gall (Gallus), an he haes gien his name tae the Swiss citie an toonlan o Saunt Gallen.

Feis Loch Lao, the Loch Lao Christyan Heirschip Feis, wull lat thon heich moral an cultural heirschip be heerd yince mair, amang the monie quirknisses o infittin an insperation, takin in yins uisin the Airish leid, yins at pit vailye oan a fowks' tradeetions, an yins farder afiel roon Bifawst Loch, wi a thair sinny waies. This can gie a spurt tae notions o brig-bigging atween fowks o a soarts frae roon Bifawst Loch.

Overview

In the Golden Age of Irish Monasticism and at a time when the Roman Empire was falling into disarray and Europe entered the Dark Ages, Saints and Scholars from Ireland journeyed across the sea to Britain and Continental Europe founding communities and libraries in Gaul, Germany and Italy.

They left written records, illuminated manuscripts and highly decorative Celtic crosses, art and artefacts behind them. Those they touched and educated often chose to journey back to Ireland to study in their turn, so that the cultural legacy of the first monks continued to migrate and evolve long after they had gone.

One of these monks, a companion of the great Columbanus, was Saint Gall or Gallus, whose name today is borne by the Swiss City and Canton of Saint Gallen.

Feis Loch Lao, The Loch Lao Christian Heritage Festival, will allow that great moral and cultural heritage to be sounded once again in its complexity for the benefit of the Irish speaking community, for those who value culture and tradition and for the wider communities of Belfast Lough in all their diversity.

At the level of principle, we hope to
remind ourselves and the world at large
that Ireland and this region of Belfast
Lough has a long and majestic history of
establishing sea routes with and cultural
havens within Europe. And this can
energise the spirit of bridge-building
between the people of Belfast Lough from
every background.

The fall of Rome ushered in what are
sometimes called the Dark Ages, but
monks, some of them from the North of
Ireland, helped ignite torches in many
areas across Britain and Europe, torches
which brought enlightenment and peace
to multitudes of people.

Feis Loch Lao intends to show just how
much light was thrown across the
shadows of time and place in those days,
and to rekindle that sense of reciprocation
and exchange – the torch that was once
passed, is twice returned.
