*Winners To Be Telecast On Fox Sports Net's BEST DAMN SPORTS SHOW PERIOD April 27<sup>th</sup>*

**New York, NY, April 21, 2003** – The 24<sup>th</sup> Annual Sports Emmy Award winners were presented by the National Academy of Television Arts and Sciences Monday, April 21, 2003. A stellar line-up of athletes, coaches and sports broadcasters including Jason Sehorn, Don Shula, Bob Costas and Boomer Esiason presented the awards to a distinguished group of broadcasting professionals at the Marriott Marquis Hotel in New York City. FOX Sports' Joe Buck hosted the event. Highlights from this year's ceremony will air on a special presentation of Fox Sports Net's BEST DAMN SPORTS SHOW PERIOD on Sunday, April 27 (6:00-8:00 PM local time).

The awards recognize outstanding achievement by individuals and programs broadcast throughout the 2002 calendar year. During the ceremony, the lifetime achievement award was presented to Boone Arledge posthumously for his legendary contributions to sports programming. Boone Arledge, Jr. accepted on behalf of his father.

“The Sports Emmy Awards honors the tremendous achievements of the professionals in the sports broadcasting world,” said Peter O. Price, president of the National Television Academy. “Tonight's ceremony reflects the quality and professionalism of sports television.”

The Sports Emmy Award recipients were chosen by a Blue Ribbon Panel of their peers from close to 700 entries in 27 categories.
