#### **TICKETS**



#### **COMMENCEMENT INFORMATION**

- 1. It is the policy of the school that all graduating seniors must participate in the commencement rehearsal on Friday, June 1, and commencement on Sunday, June 3. Participation in rehearsal and commencement activities **is essential** to complete the requirements for graduation from high school. The **parents** of any student who is ill and unable to attend any one of these activities **must contact Dr. Cantrell immediately at 847-718-4810.**
- 2. Please urge family and friends to withhold applause while diplomas are being issued.
- 3. Please request family and friends to refrain from taking pictures while the processional lines are forming for commencement.
- 4. Please demonstrate dignified behavior throughout the entire ceremony.
- 5. Students are required to dress appropriately (dress pants/skirts) for this occasion. Shorts, sandals and gym shoes are <u>not</u> appropriate attire. <u>Any student not dressed appropriately will be sent home to change clothes</u>.
- 6. Flowers of any kind (corsages, bouquets, etc.) <u>are not</u> permitted with the graduates during the ceremony. The only items to be worn on the gown are those received at the Honors Assembly on Friday, June 1.
- 7. At the conclusion of the ceremony graduates will go to the Fieldhouse.
  - a. Turn in rental gown in the Wrestling Room and receive a ticket.
  - b. Find your counselor in the Fieldhouse, give him/her the ticket to receive your diploma. A copy of your immunization record will be included with your diploma.

### Principal's Message...

On a very serious note, I want to remind you that participation in many of our end-of-the-year activities for seniors are privileges, not rights. Hersey High School has the right to deny any student who has broken school rules the privilege of participating in one or more end-of-the-year events. This includes attending prom, as well as participating in the graduation ceremony. Please understand that students who make poor choices which result in any participation in a school prank, vandalism, and/or a substance abuse violation including any kind of alcohol or drug usage, will receive significant consequences. These consequences very well may include losing the privilege of attending any or all of the end-of-the-year activities in which seniors traditionally participate (senior awards assembly, senior picnic, prom, graduation, senior class picture, etc.). Please make sure that your student fully understands the ramifications of inappropriate actions long before the end-of-the-year activities take place. These are very important events in the lives of our seniors, and I want every student to have the opportunity to participate and to leave Hersey with positive memories of the last weeks of the senior year.

Please also be aware of the fact that Hersey High School takes the completion of District 214 graduation requirements very seriously. Only students who have met all graduation requirements prior to commencement will be allowed to participate in the ceremony. If you have a senior student who needs to pass specific classes to meet graduation requirements, I urge you to discuss this topic with your student.
