



## U-verse Update: 2Q12 AT&T Delivers More Content to the Second-Screen


AT&T U-verse® continued to get even better during the second quarter of 2012, with additional interactive apps introduced for consumer integration and flexibility.¹ We launched several enhancements to the U-verse App for iPad, making it easy for customers to bring their TV and mobile device experiences together for a truly integrated experience. Below is a recap of our AT&T U-verse growth and highlights for the second quarter.

## SERVICE GROWTH: Customers Continue to Choose U-verse TV

- 4.1 million U-verse TV customers.
- 2.6 million U-verse Voice connections.
- 6.5 million U-verse High Speed Internet customers.
- About 90 percent of U-verse TV customers bundle High Speed Internet.
- About half of new U-verse TV customers bundle U-verse Voice.
- About 75 percent of U-verse TV customers have a triple- or quad-play.
- AT&T U-verse bundles available in 138 markets (MSAs) across 22 states.
- AT&T U-verse now has annualized revenues of approximately **\$9 billion**.

## SERVICE EVOLUTION: More Enhancements for an Even Better Second-Screen Experience

- AT&T U-verse announced several enhancements to the U-verse App, making it easy for users to integrate their mobile device with their TV.
- Launched the Yahoo! Sports tab for customers to access up to the minute sports content on their iPad – with more features to come.
- Introduced Twitter connectivity to the U-verse for iPad App for users to share information about the shows they're watching.
- Added the Remote Control Feature to the U-verse App for smartphones, giving users the ability to control the TV with a full-featured, intuitive U-verse remote control.<sup>2</sup>
- Added additional premium content from HBO, Starz and Cinemax to the U-verse App's content library.
