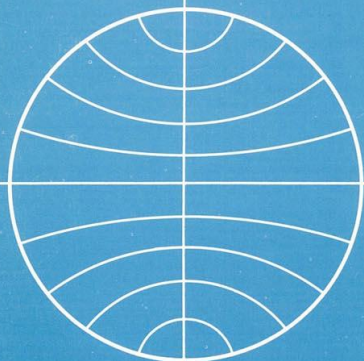
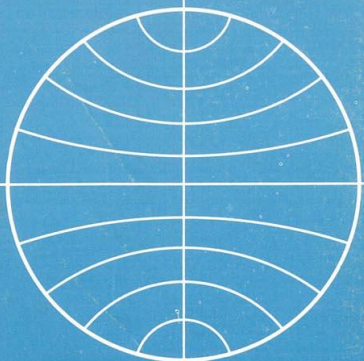

### HOW TO USE THE TIME TABLE

**TO FIND DESIRED SERVICE**—Locate origin and destination in the List of Cities, Pages 46-47, and refer to Table Numbers common to both.

**LIST OF CITIES**—A list of principal cities, office airports, transfer times and charges are on Pages 46 and 47.

**ROUTE MAP**—A world map, on which Pan American World Airways System routes are indicated, will be found on Pages 24-25.

**THE 24-HOUR CLOCK IS USED IN THIS TIME TABLE**—Times shown between 001 (1 minute after midnight) and 1200 (noon) are A.M. times and are shown in

### SCHEDULES AND TYPES OF AIRCRAFT

### PASSENGER INFORMATION

**When requesting reservations please specify class of service.**

**INCLUSIVE TOURS:** Pan Am Holidays are available to most of the destinations listed in this timetable. For complete details, consult your travel agent or any office of Pan American.

**TRAVEL FUNDS:** You are urged to carry the major portion of your funds in the form of Travelers' Checks, Money Orders, Letters of Credit, etc. However, cash, preferably U. S. dollars—in small denominations should also be available.

**PASSPORTS AND VISAS:** In order to travel from one country to another, you must in most cases have a valid passport appropriately visaed where required, and other permits for certain countries. While we normally have available all the latest information, we are not responsible for its accuracy and urge you to consult the nearest consulate of the country you propose to visit in order to obtain official advice.

**ARRIVAL AT EMBARKATION POINTS:** There are certain governmental formalities which must be completed before an international flight may depart, and we must request that you arrive at the designated point—either airport or city dispatch office—in time for the completion of these formalities (your ticket envelope will bear a notation of the appropriate time and place). Flights will not be delayed to accommodate passengers arriving too late for completion of these formalities.

**FARES:** Fares for round trips and circle trips are generally 10% less than the sum of the one-way fares for such a trip, and considerably greater savings are available on some routes at certain times of the year.

**Children's Fares:** An accompanied child two years of age or over, but under twelve, will be charged half of the normal adult fare. Children under two years of age generally will be charged 10% of the normal adult fare, except that no charge will be assessed for children under two years of age on Puerto Rico and/or the Continental U.S.A. Only one child under two years of age accompanying a seat will be carried free (or at 10% as above) with each accompanying adult; additional children will be charged half fare. For other fares of accompanied and unaccompanied children see Official Tariff.

**Berths:** Are available at extra charge on all PAA First Class Flights in the Round The World, Atlantic and Pacific services, also available on PAA and PANAGRA Latin America services. See page 45 for charges.

**RECONFIRMATION OF RESERVATIONS:** Whenever you stopover, please reconfirm your intention to use your return or continuing reservation. Please advise the nearest office or general agency in person or by telephone, wire, cable, radio or mail and include your local address or telephone number in the city where you will board your flight. Failure to receive reconfirmation advice prior to the appropriate time limit indicated will necessitate cancellation of your reservations if space is needed.

**RATES** are attractive and decrease as the weights of the shipments increase; classified and specific commodity rates offer additional advantages between many points.

**PACKING:** Light weight packing is sufficient for air cargo.

**AVAILABILITY:** Confirmed space for shipments from a few kilos/pounds up to 12 tons can be reserved to most places in 80 countries.

**PASSENGER FARES**—Passenger fares between many important points on the Pan American World Airways System are given on Pages 41 through 46.

**Passenger and Cargo Tariffs**, which are available for inspection at any Pan American office, are subject to change without notice.

### MEALS

**STOPOVERS:** You may arrange to stop over at any scheduled stop on your trip—with a few exceptions—provided that you arrange for stopovers prior to departure from the airport preceding your desired stopover.

**MEALS:** In First and Tourist Class services complimentary meals are served aloft or on the ground at conventional mealtimes, except that no complimentary meals will be served on Tourist or Thrift Flights between New York/Miami and San Juan.

**TAKES:** Transportation taxes imposed by some governments are not included in the fares quoted and will be collected where they apply.

**BAGGAGE:** Passengers paying the adult applicable fares are allowed the following free baggage allowances which shall include both checked and un-checked baggage, except as otherwise provided:

**First Class Services:** Generally 20 kilograms (66 pounds).

**Tourist Class Services:** Generally 20 kilograms (44 pounds).

**Combined Services:** For through journeys where travel is partly via First Class Service and partly via Tourist Class, the free baggage allowance for each portion of the trip is that applicable to the class of service for which the fare is paid. A passenger paying a First Class fare but traveling via Tourist Class Service is entitled to the First Class free baggage allowance.

**Children paying 1/2 fare** are granted free baggage allowance on the same basis as a passenger paying an adult fare and subject to the same exceptions.

**Children traveling free or at the 10% fare** receive no free baggage allowance.

**All baggage** must be weighed including brief cases, typewriters and large cameras, which are not stored aboard aircraft by the passenger. The only exceptions are: lady's handbag or pocketbook; an overcoat or wrap; a footbag; an umbrella or walking stick; a small camera and a pair of binoculars; a reasonable amount of reading matter for the flight; an infant's food for consumption enroute, an infant's carrying basket or bassinet, a fully collapsible wheelchair, only for passenger dependent upon such equipment.

**Excess Weight Charges:** All baggage in excess of the above free allowances will be charged for at 1% of the normal adult first class one-way fare per kilo. See Official Tariff for special charges for transportation of Ski Equipment.

**Excess Value** may be declared on baggage at a nominal charge.

**Cabin and Checked Baggage**—Since checked baggage will not be available during flight, it is suggested that on flights which include overnight travel you should carry a small overnight bag for toilet articles, etc., which you may carry in the cabin.

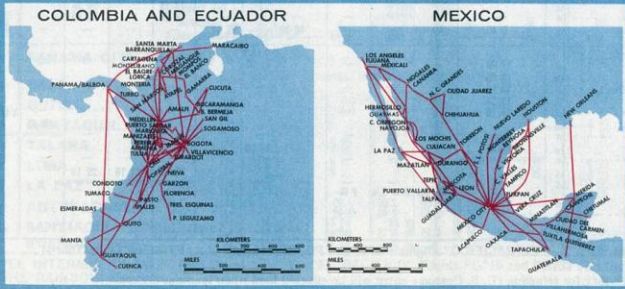
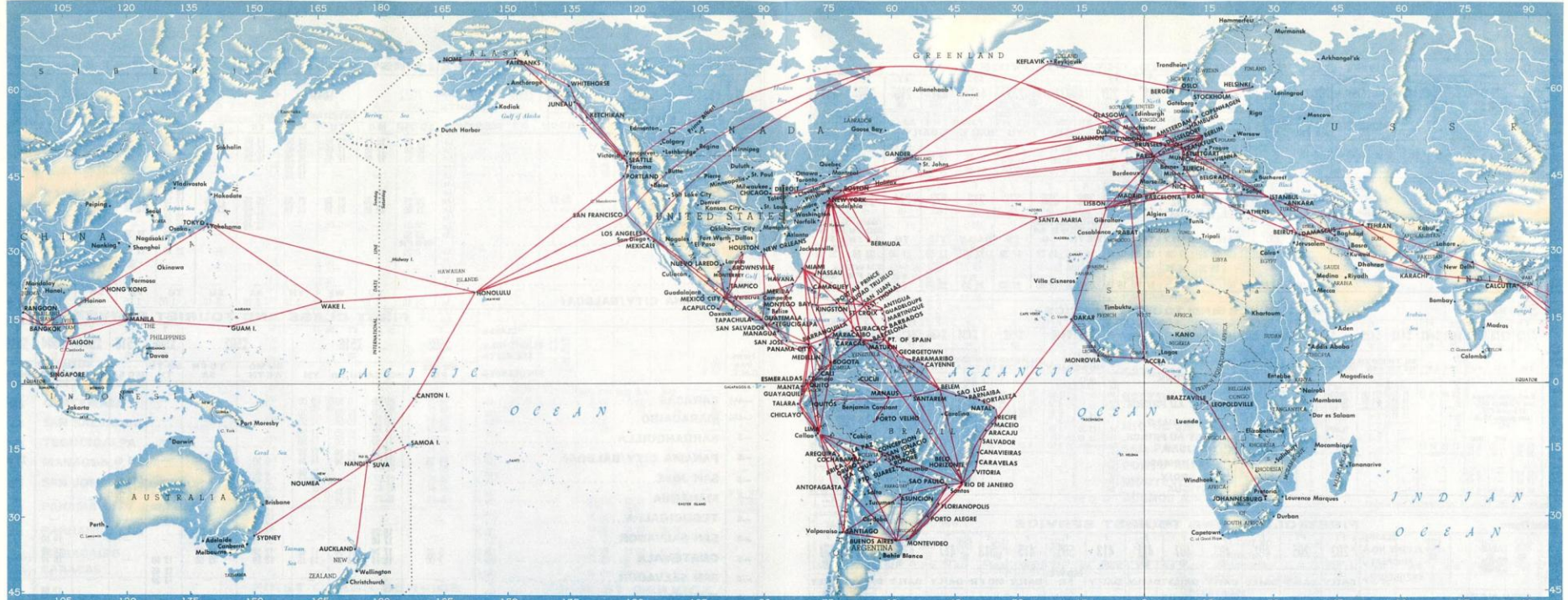

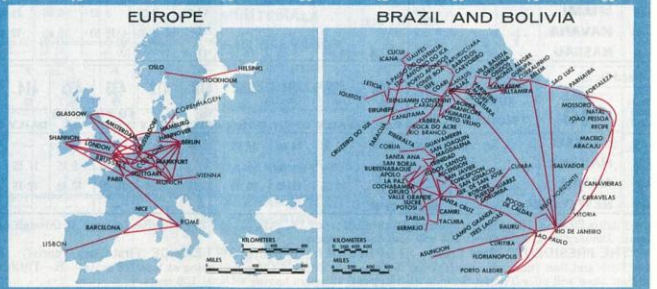
