Has served/serves as consultant to the US National Security Council, the White House Chief of Staff, the US Department of Defense, US Department of State, US Air Force, and several EU allied governments.

Has taught at Johns Hopkins University and Georgetown University. Has been an invited lecturer at universities, research centers and war colleges in many countries.
