SHELBY HALL IS A 155,000-SQUARE-FOOT STATE OF THE ART FACILITY BUILT PRIMARILY WITH FEDERAL GRANTS SECURED THROUGH THE EFFORTS OF UNITED STATES SENATOR RICHARD C. SHELBY. SHELBY HALL HOUSES USA'S COLLEGE OF ENGINEERING AND SCHOOL OF COMPUTING. IT FEATURES 63 LABORATORIES, 17 CLASSROOMS, 3 LARGE MULTIMEDIA AUDITORIUM CLASSROOMS, 5 COMPUTER LABS, 5 STUDENT STUDY AREAS, 7 STUDENT DESIGN ROOMS, OFFICES FOR FACULTY AND STAFF, AND MUCH MORE. DEDICATION OF THE BUILDING MARKS THE BEGINNING OF A YEAR-LONG CELEBRATION OF THE UNIVERSITY OF SOUTH ALABAMA'S 50TH ANNIVERSARY.
