About the Survey

- The results of the survey can be published from January 2, 2012 at 1 PM Egyptian time (or 12 am GMT)
- The survey contains 1000 responses from randomly selected Egyptian nationals, aged 18 years and above in governorates, where voting will take place on January 3: **Menia, Qalubiya, Gharbia, Dakhlia, North Sinai, South Sinai, El Wadi El Gadid, Matruh, Qena**
- The survey was conducted by Al-Ahram Centre for Political and Strategic Studies (ACPSS) from December 17 to December 27 via face-to-face interviews.
- Results can only be published using the quote "survey by Al-Ahram Centre for Political and Strategic Studies".
- This survey is supported by a group of international organizations led by the Danish-Egyptian Dialogue Institute (DEDI).

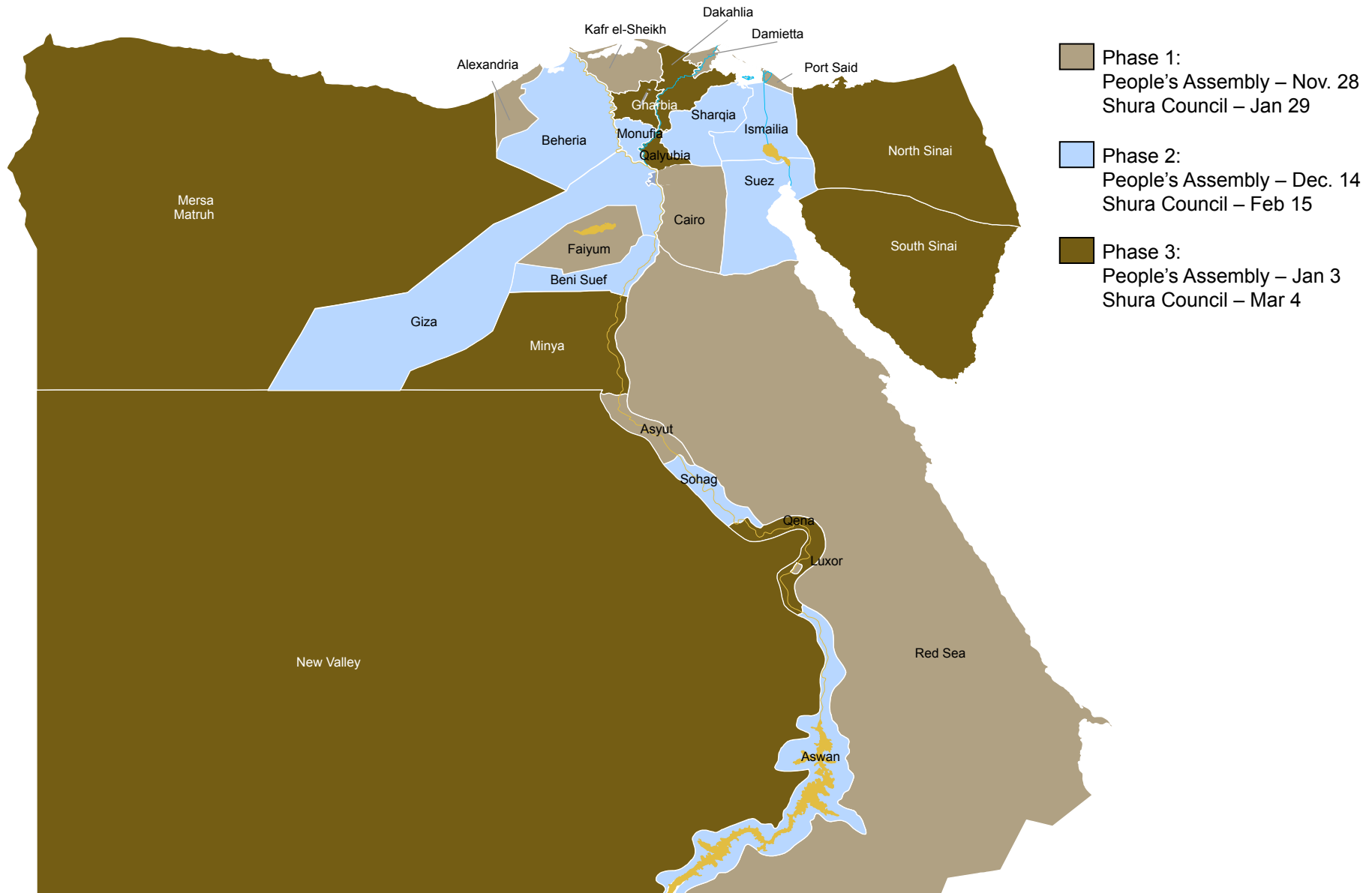

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Summary of Key Findings

December 17-27 2011, Governorates of Third Election Round in Egypt

- **The Nour Party continues the strong showing from election round 1 and 2.** The Nour Party is expected to get support from around 19% of the decided voters, which is a big increase from previous polls done in the same governorates.
- **The support for the Freedom and Justice Party has steadily increased its support with more than 50% of the vote significantly up from previous polls.**
- **Al Wafd is expected to be strongest liberal party ahead of the Egyptian Bloc in election round 3 continuing its increase in support from election round 1 and 2.**
- **2 out 10 voters are still undecided the lowest proportion of undecided voters in any of the polls.**

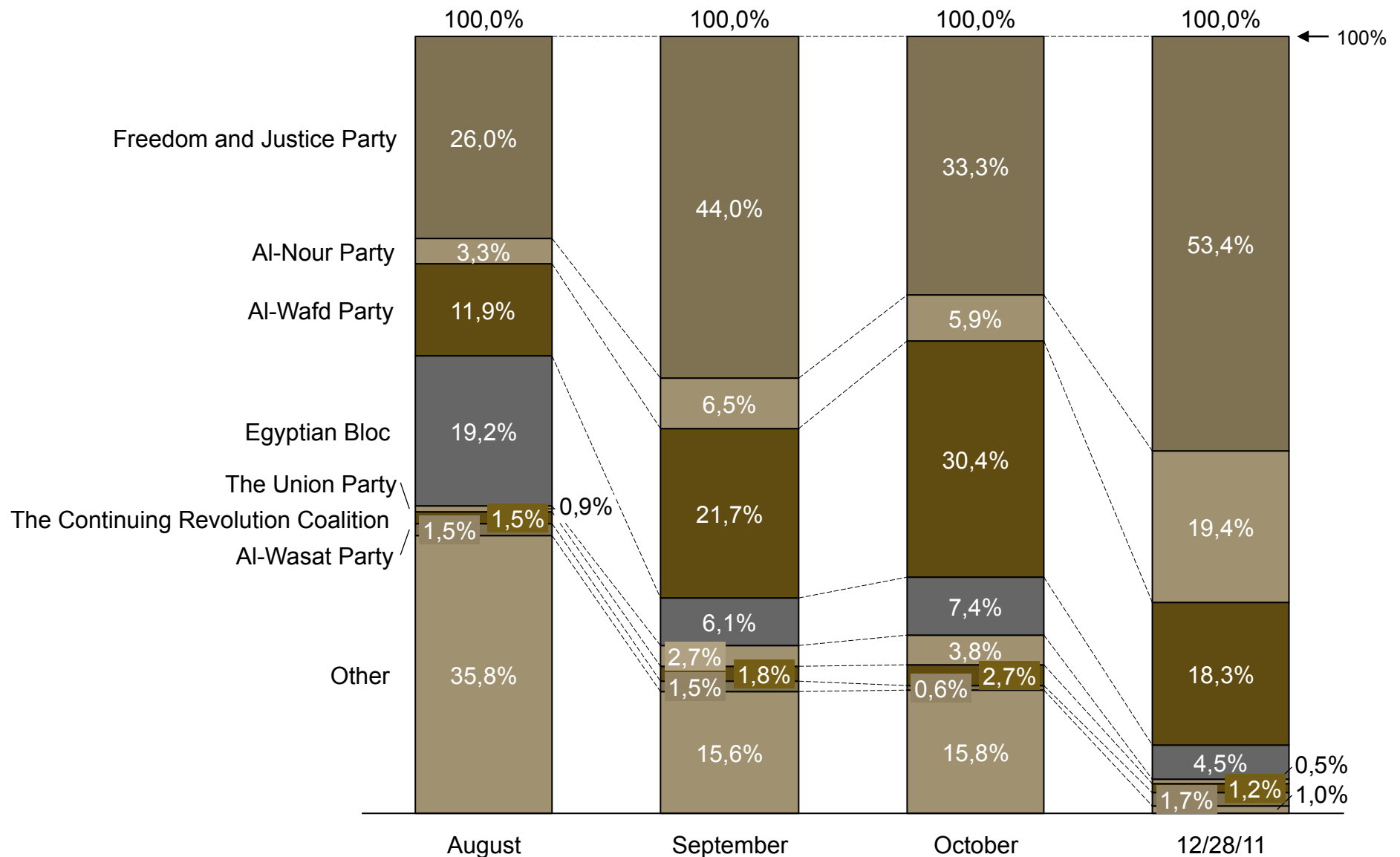
