## NOTES

The Greater London Council is composed of 92 councillors - one for each of the 92 electoral divisions which are the same as parliamentary constituencies. Elections are held on the day fixed by section 43 of the Local Government Act 1972 which shall be the first Thursday in May unless some other day is fixed by the Home Secretary.

In 1976, the Home Secretary made an Order under the Local Government Act 1972 providing for elections at four-yearly intervals. Previously, since 1964, elections had been held every three years.
