Notes

The composition of the Greater London Council is 92 councillors and 15 aldermen. The date of the 1973 election was fixed by the Council under section 2 of the London Government Act 1967. Subsequent elections will be held on the day fixed by section 43 of the Local Government Act 1972 which shall be the first Thursday in May unless some other day is fixed by the Home Secretary.

For the 1973 and subsequent elections the representation is one councillor for each of the single-member electoral divisions corresponding with parliamentary constituencies. The Council is required to arrange by-elections whenever vacancies are notified, subject to the provisions of section 89 of the Local Government Act 1972. Since 1964 elections have been held every third year but the Local Government Act 1972 empowers the Home Secretary to make an Order providing for elections at four-yearly intervals.

Aldermen are elected by the councillors from among councillors or persons qualified to be councillors.

At the time of going to print, the seat for Croydon North East was subject to High Court action to have the election declared invalid.
