Notes

The initial composition of the Greater London Council is 100 councillors and 16 aldermen. Elections are held every third year on a day fixed by the Home Secretary. Aldermen, eight of whom retire every third year, are elected by the councillors from among councillors or persons qualified to be councillors.

Each of the 32 London boroughs (one of them – the City of Westminster – joined with the City of London and the Inner and Middle Temples) has so far returned two, three or four councillors. When revised Parliamentary constituencies are settled each London constituency will return one councillor. A report of the Parliamentary Boundary Commission incorporating new Greater London constituencies was put before Parliament in 1969. This engendered considerable political controversy, the outcome of which was that the draft Order in Council giving effect to recommendations of the Boundary Commission was defeated on a vote of the House of Commons. Thus the 1970 election of Greater London councillors was again based on multi-member constituencies.

New features of this election in consequence of the Representation of the People Act 1969 were the admission to the electorate of the 18-21 year olds, the abandonment of the non-resident qualification for membership and for voting at local government elections and the right of candidates to describe their political affiliation on the ballot paper. The last led to some rather bizarre descriptions in a few instances, e.g., 'Bread and Circus' and 'All Night' parties.
