A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO THE CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA RELATING TO THE CORPORATION COMMISSION; PROVIDING FOR DEFINITION OF PUBLIC SERVICE CORPORATIONS TO INCLUDE CERTAIN TELECOMMUNICATION CORPORATIONS; PROVIDING FOR LIMITATION ON TELECOMMUNICATIONS CORPORATIONS AS COMMON CARRIERS SUBJECT TO CONTROL BY LAW; PROVIDING THAT THE CORPORATION COMMISSION SHALL TAKE ACTION ASSURING CERTAIN TELECOMMUNICATION SERVICE; PRESCRIBING TRANSMISSION OF MESSAGES BY CONNECTING CARRIERS; PRESCRIBING EXCEPTION FOR CERTAIN TELECOMMUNICATION CORPORATIONS FROM PROPERTY VALUATION REQUIRED BY PUBLIC SERVICE CORPORATIONS, AND AMENDING ARTICLE XV, SECTIONS 2, 3, 9, 10 AND 14, CONSTITUTION OF ARIZONA.
