I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

- An earthquake of tectonic origin with 7.2 magnitude (Ms) occurred in Region VII on 15 October 2013 at about 8:12 AM with an epicentre at Sagbayan, Bohol
- As of **4:00 AM, 03 November 2013**, PHIVOLCS recorded **3,198** aftershocks, **94** of which were felt

II. EFFECTS

A. INCIDENTS MONITORED:

- Landslide incidents were reported in the municipalities of Boljoon, Aloguinsa, Argao, Cebu; and in the municipalities of Clarin, Lila, Corella, Balilihan, Alicia, Loboc, Bilar, Cortes, Dimiao, Antequera, Loon, Danao all of Bohol.
- Stampede occurred at Barba Sports Complex in Toledo City and Pinamungahan Auditorium both in Cebu
- At 29 October 2013, a ground subsidence (sink hole) with a very high landslide susceptibility rating was reported by the Mines and Geoscience Bureau (MGB) at Purok 7 and 8 Barangay Poblacion I, Tagbilaran City, Bohol. Houses near the developed sinkhole were advised to initiate readiness and advised to preemptively evacuate

B. CASUALTIES (TAB A) (See SitRep 33)

- To date, **222** individuals are reported dead, **976** injured, and **8** are missing

C. AFFECTED POPULATION (TAB B)

- A total of **671,103 families / 3,221,248 persons** were affected in **1,527** barangays in **60** municipalities and **6** cities in **6** provinces of Regions VI and VII
- Out of the total affected, **71,822 families / 348,507 persons** were displaced and served both inside and outside evacuation centers in the Province of Bohol:

Inside **392** Evacuation Centers: **17,203 families / 79,773 persons**
Outside Evacuation Centers: **54,619 families / 268,734 persons**

D. DAMAGES

Damaged Structures (TAB C)

- A total of **73,002 houses** were damaged (**14,512 totally / 58,490 partially**) in Bohol, Cebu, Negros Occidental, Negros Oriental, Iloilo, Siquijor and Guimaras
- Seaports, airports, churches, government/public buildings, schools, and hospitals were also damaged in the Provinces of Bohol, Cebu, Iloilo, Negros Occidental, Negros Oriental, Siquijor and Leyte in Regions VI and VII

Damaged Roads and Bridges (TAB D) (See SitRep 33)

- A total of **41 bridges** were affected of which **38** are already passable and **3** are still not passable, in the Provinces of Bohol, Cebu and Negros Occidental
- A total of **18 roads** were affected of which **16** are now passable and **2** are still not passable in the Provinces of Bohol and Cebu

E. COST OF ASSISTANCE (TAB E)

- **As of 6:00 AM, 03 November 2013**, The total cost of assistance provided by DSWD, DOH, LGUs and NGOs to Regions VI and VII amounted to **PhP71,560,993.47**
- Financial assistance was given to the bereaved families of **182 dead** victims at **PhP10,000.00** each for a total of **PhP1,820,000.00**

F. COST OF DAMAGES (TAB F) (See SitRep 33)

- A total of **PhP2,257,337,182.90** worth of damaged roads, bridges, flood control, school buildings, hospitals, and other public buildings was reported in the Provinces of Cebu (PhP819,051,000.00), Bohol (PhP1,383,159,000.00), Negros Oriental (PhP270,000.00), Siquijor (PhP1,450,000.00), Kabankalan City (PhP1,024,000.00), Bacolod City (PhP11,980,411.67), Candoni (PhP402,771.23), and Capiz (PhP40,000,000.00)
