Charge demolition "Hayrick" No.14, 11Lb is a steel vee-linear cutting charge for use against re-inforced concrete targets such as bridge piers. A linear shaped charge unit filled with 5.3 kg of high explosive primed with a powerful HE booster unit to ensure good performance.

The charge can be used individually, as shown here, or as a 'necklace' of five units (see Mondial Part 1-MD-28). Initiation is usually by the detonating cord passed through the hole in the priming pellet.

Operation

For single unit use:

- 1. Position charge over target to be cut.
- 2. Remove brass bolt located through turret.
- 3. Insert detonating cord through turret hole.
- 4. Ensure range safety procedures are in operation.
- 5. Initiate detonating cord using a service or commercial detonator of at least strength no 8.

The charge can be initiated using either an electric or non-electric detonator.
