Margin of Error: +/-2.93%

- Survey conducted with a random sample of registered voters (drawn from official Iowa Secretary of State voter file) who voted in the 2012 general election or have registered since the 2012 election.
- Likely voter was defined within the sample drawn as those indicating they were "extremely likely" or "very likely" to vote in the 2014 election.
- The sample was balanced for standard demographic variables such as age, gender, geography, as well as party based on recent historical performance.
- Survey included both landlines (80 percent) and cell phones (20 percent).
- Margin of Error for Congressional District subsamples is +/- 5.85 percent.
- The survey was conducted using live operator interviews through a contracted professional call center.
- Script development and methodology used for the survey received input from Republican campaign consultant Steve Grubbs, and Democratic campaign consultant Dave Heller.
