

# **CHAPTER 1 Introduction**

#### District at a Glance

**Background, Geographic Area and Location**: Patuakhali is a district in South-western Bangladesh. It is a part of the Barisal Division. This is the main entrance for the beach of Kuakata. This district is famous for watching both the sun rise and sun set. It is situated at the fringe of the Bay of Bengal. It became a sub division of Barisal district 1871 and was upgraded to a separate district on December 1, 1983. It is bounded on the north by Barisal district, on the east by Bhola district, on the south by the Bay of Bengal and on the west by Barguna. It lies between 21°48' and 22°36' north latitudes and between 90°08' and 90°41' east longitudes. The total area of the district is 3221.31 sq. km and 71.33 sq. km is under forest.

**Temperature and Rainfall:** Annual average temperature of this district varies from maximum 25.3°C to minimum 12.2°C and anual rainfall 2377 mm.

Main Rivers: The Andharmanik, Agunmukha, Payra, Lohalia, Patuakhali, Tentulia etc. are main rivers of this district.

**Administration:** Patuakhali district consists of 7 upazilas, 71 unions, 561 mauzas, 878 villages, 5 paurashavas, 45 wards and 82 mahallas. The upazilas are Bauphal, Dashmina, Dumki, Galachipa, Kalapara, Mirzaganj and Patuakhali Sadar.

Historical Events: Patuakhali district had been included within the ancient Kingdom of Chandradvipa. Kachua under Bauphal upazila had once been the capital of the kingdom. Due to natural calamities on the coastal areas and the frequent Partuguese and Magh raids the capital was transferred to Madhabpasha in Barisal. Raja Todarmal, Revenue minister of Emperor Akbar, sent a kanungo Jimmak Khan to Chandradvipa in 1599 to survey the area. The forest area of Chandradvipa was separated from Chandradvipa and marked as 'bazuha' or protected region. Three parganas such as Selimabad, Buzurg Umedpur and Aurangpur were then constituted in this region. In the last quarter of the eighteenth century, huge number of Buddhist Rakhains of Arakan escaped the atrocities of the Burmese king to this district and settled at Rangabali Island of Galachipa upazila, Khepupara and Kuakata in Kalapara upazila. Since then human settlement began to grow in this region.

During the liberation war in 197, three Pak armies were killed in an encounter between the Pak army and the freedom fighters at village Panpatti in Galachipa upazila. On 8 May,1971, the Pak army raided the villages of Chikanikandi and Dakua, killed 29 villagers and sacked many houses and establishments. In a conflict between the local freedom fighters and the Pak army on the border of Mirzaganj, 32 freedom fighters including a commander were killed while a considerable number of Pak army were either killed or wounded. A battle was fought between the Pak army and the freedom fighters on the Kumarkhali River near Kalisuri in Bauphal upazila. The Pak army killed 35 villagers by gunshot at Madanpura and Dhulia and racked many houses.

Archaeological Heritage and Relics: Sutabaria Dayamayee Mandir (1208 BS), Gurinda Masjid at Ratandi, Sreerampur Mian Bari Mosque, Talukdar Bari Jami Mosque (Dashmina), Betagi Sikdaria Jami Mosque, Dighi of Kaviray-bari (Dashmina), Kuakata Buddist Vihara, Kapradanga Buddhist Math, Mistri-para Buddist Vihara (Kalapara), Mosque of Ghaseti Begum (1757) at village Shaula, Pakdal Mian Bari Masjid, Bauphal Central Kalibari Mandir (1875), Kachari (revenue office) of Rajendra Mahendra Babu and of Som at Daspara in Bauphal, Tomb of Syed Arefin at Kalisuri, Ashram of Mahendra Pagla, Dargah of Tamir at Kalaya, Mitha Pukur (pond) at Daspara, Kanai Balai dighee, Kamala Rani dighee at Kachua, Mosque of Munshi Amirullah, Holy bathing place at Ponahura, Tomb of Sultan Fakir at Baufal, Dol Samudra dighee, Blackhole at Sikdar house of Madanpura, Rajapur wall, Shahi Mosque at Masjidbaria of Mirzaganj etc.are notable archaeological heritage and relics of this district.

**Marks of War of Liberation**: Mass grave, inside the old jail compound, at southwestern side of the new jail and at Tulatali, Memorial monument in front of the old town hall, memorial monument at the premises of Muktiyoddha Sangsad etc. are marks of war of liberation of Patuakhali district.

**Locally published Newspapers and Periodicals:** The Daily Rupantar, Tentulia, Ganadabi, Sathi, Weekly Payra, fortnightly Metho Barta etc. are locally published newspapers and periodicals of this district.

**Main Crops**: Paddy, jute, potato, mug, lentil, khesari, gram, sesame, chilli, mustard, linseed, coriander seed, ground nut, betel leaf, sugarcane, watermelon, vegetables etc. are main crops of this district.

Main Fruits: Mango, jackfruit, banana, papaya, guava, plum, lemon, coconut, betel nut, palm, wood nut, kaijou nut etc. are main fruits of this district.

Economic Situation: The economy of Patuakhali district is predominately agricultural. Out of a total 323,502 holdings of the district, 65% holdings are farms and remaining 34.04% are nonfarms. Farm-holdings produce varieties of crops, namely local and HYV rice, wheat, vegetables, spices, cash crops, pulses, oilseeds, maize and others. Various fruits like banana, jackfruits, guava, coconut, etc. are grown. Fishes of various species abound in the district like other parts of the country. Varieties of fish are caught from rivers, tributary channels and creeks and from paddy fields during rainy season. In the fresh water popular fish species are ruhi, katla, mrigel, kalbous, airh, ghania, shoel, boal, gulsha, koi, shing, magur, etc. In marine water hilsha, prawn and pangas fishes are famous. The district has plenty of fishery resources. Besides, crops, livestock, forestry and fishery are the main source of household income. Valuable timber and other forest trees are also grown in this district.

Non-farm activities play a partial role in the economy of Patuakhali. The following table-1 shows total establishments and persons engaged by sex and activity in the district.

According to the above table, there are 37,367 establishments in the district where 95,079 persons are engaged in different types of non-farm activities. Female participation in non-farm activities is very poor. They constitute about 5.37% females as against 94.63% males. Wholesale & retail trade emerges as the single largest activity (45.34%) with 21,362 establishments. Males and females engaged in the sector are 42,249 (46.96%) and only 857 (16.78%) persons respectively. The second highest establishment of activities is the community, social and personal services numbering 5,838 which engage 10,013 persons. In consideration of personnel strength, the education establishment is next to the wholesale and retail trade engaging a total of 13,952 persons.

#### Flora and Fauna

**Flora**: Patuakhali district has a bit different characteristics in nature due to its combination of broad non-saline and saline tidal flood plain area. The northern part of the district lies in the non-saline tidal flood plain area and the southern part in the saline. As a result, the district combines flora and fauna of both characteristics.

The district has wide variety of trees, shrubs and thickets of bamboos and bananas that surround the village homesteads. The district is covered with trees common throughout Bangladesh such as mango (Mangifera indica), kanthal or jackfruit (Artocarpus heterophyllus), bel or wood apple (Aegle marmelos), narikel or coconut (Cocos nucifera), ataphal (Anona squamosa), Sharifa or sweet hop (Annona squamoss), kamranga or carambola (Averrho karambola), latkan (Baccaurea ramiflora), tal or plam (Borassus flabellifer), Kadam (Anthocephalus cadamba), pitraj or rona (Aphanamixls polystachia), supuri (Areca catechu), neem (Azadirachta indica), bamboo (Bambusa valgaris), tallabans or tella bamboo (Bambusa tulda), hijol (Barringtonia acutangula), ooriam

(Bischofia javanica), simul or cotton (Bombax ceiba), belati gab or belati magostecn (Diospysos kaki), palash (Butea monosperna), papaya or pepe (Carica papaya), sonalu (Cassia fistula), Jambura or lime (Citrus decumana), mandar (Erythrina variegata), bat or banyan (Ficus benghalensis), ashatha or pipul (Ficus religiosa), dumur or fig (Ficus hispida), jarul (Legerstroemia speciosa), deshi gab or mangosteen (Diospysos peregrine), sajna (Moringa obifera), khejur or date plam (Phoenix sylvestris), debdaru or pine (Polyalathia longifolia), piyara or guava (Psidium guajava), rain tree (Samanca saman), kalojam or black berry (Syzygium cumini), jat koroi (Albizzia procera), etc.

Besides the above, the following trees are peculiar to this area: ponyal (*Calophylluminophyllum*), ghau (*Casuarina equisetifolia*), chaltha or acid fruit (*Dillenia indica*), karamja (*Pongamia pinnata*), shoila (*Sonneratia caseolaris*), bilati amra (*Spondias dulcis*), kewat kanta (*Pandamustectorius*), paras (*Thespesia populnea*), jalpai or olive ((*Eleaeocarpus tectorius*).

Moreover, a few types of Sundarban trees are still found in the district. These are gab (*Diospyros precatorius*), haritoki (*Terminalia chebula*), keora (*Sonneratia apetala*), baira (*Zejyphus jujiba*), etc. Reeds known as Hoglapata grow in the marshes and on the river banks. Golpata, a kind of palm is very important. Its stems are used for roofing houses. Its fruits are edible and molasses (gur) is made from its juice. The surface of the marshes either shows huge stretches of inundated rice or is covered by matted flowing islets of sedges and grass and with various water lilies, the most striking of which is makhna (*Euryale ferox*).

Some species of shrubs like harjaza (*Acanthus ilicefolius*), nona jhaw (*Tamarix dioscoria*), tamrbul kata (*Dalborgia spinosa*), sodabaen (*Avicenia alba*), sundri lata (*Brownlowia lanceolata*), singara (*Cynometru ramiflora*), khalsi (*Acgiceras majus*), hantab (*Phoenix paludosa*), etc. are also seen in the area.

The district is essentially an agricultural district. The main agricultural crops are rice, wheat, jute, pulses, oil seeds, vegetables, spices, sugarcane, tobacco, etc. Among rice crops Aman crops occupy the largest area followed by Aus and Boro. The fruit crops of importance are banana and coconut. The crop which is very commonly grown and is of speciality for the district is betelnut.

#### **Fauna**

*Mammals:* Due to ruthless destruction of the Sundarban portion of the forest in the district of Patuakhali, most of the wild animals are now rarely seen in this area. Despite importance of ecological integrity and bio-diversity, the species of fauna in this region are being affected by over exploitation, deforestation, inefficient forest management, agricultural and industrial pollution etc. A proper inventory of the rich biological resources of the country should be made and the economic, social, ecological and ethical values of bio-diversity are yet to be realised and disseminated by all concerned. However, there are some vertebrate species of various classes of fauna that are common to the adjoining districts are also found in the district. The names of few species belonging to each class are given in the following paragraphs.

Commonly found mammals are ud biral (*Aonyx cinerea*), benji (*Herpestes edwardsi*), Indur (*Rattus rattus*), nengti indur (*Bandicota bengalensis*), dura kathbirali (*Funambulus pennanti*), tickell's bat (*Hesperoptenus tickelli*) and chika (*Suncus murinus*).

Birds: The birds usually seen in the district are babui or baya weaver (*Ploceus phillippinus*), meutushi (*Nectarinea Athene brama*), kalo kokil or cuckoo (*Cuculus microplerus*), tia or parrot (*Psillacula krameri*), ghugu or dove (*Streptophelia orientalis*), botkol (*Treron phoenicoptera*), dahuk or white breasted water (*Amaurornis phoenicurus*), korchey bok (*Ardeola grayii*), pankoyri (*Phalacrococan niger*), etc.

**Reptiles and Amphibians:** Among the reptilia tiktiki (*Hemidactylus brooki*) is the most common and best known. Other reptiles that are commonly seen are gui shap (*Varanus salvator*), dhora shap (*Xenochrophis piscator*), gharginni shap (*Lycodon jara*), jait shap (*Naja kaouthia*), etc. The amphibians are not rich in species, but very much so in numbers. Among them the most common are kotkoti bang (*Rana cyanophlyctis*), bhawa beng (*Rana cyanophlyctis*), kuno beng (*Bufo melanostictus*) and jhi jhi beng (*Rana limnocharis*).

Fishes: Both fresh water and marine fishes as very essential staple play a very important role in the economy of the locality. The fresh water fishes are ruhi or salmon (Labeo rohita), mrigel or trout (Cirrhinus mrigala), kalboush (Labeo calbasu), katla or carp (Catla catla), etc. Soil fish or walking fish (Ophicephalus-steiaxtus), shingl (Heteropneustes fossilis), scorpion-fish or singi are also found in large quantity in beels and khals. Many other spieces of river and fresh water fishes are also found in the district. Of these the principal varieties are, dhain, chital (Notopterus chitala), ghona, airh (Mystus aor), bagar (Bagarius bagarius), pangas (Pangasius pangasius), boal (Wallago attu), rita (Rita rita), bain or eel fish (Mastacembelus armatus), chapila (Gudusia chapra), bhagna (Labeo boga), nandail bacha, pon, gargle (Arius gagora), kaulia, kapali, khorsols, mehsir, golsha (Mystus bleekeri), tengra (Mystus vittatus), chanda (Mene muculata), tekchanda (Gerres argyreus), kachki (Corica soborna), baila (Glossogobius giuris), bheda (Nandus nandus), batashi (Pseudoutropius atherinoides), kakila (Strogylura strogylura), phalli or flat fish (Notopterus notopterus), tatkeni (Crosscheilus latius), pabda or butter fish (Ompok pabda), chela (Chela cachius), gangchela, gajal (Channa marulius), koi or climbing fish (Anabas testudineus), bele or baila (Eleotris ambinensis), kholisha (Colisa fasciatus), punti (Barbus puntius), sharputi (Puntius sarana), taki (Channa punctatus), walking fish (Ophicephalus striaxtus), malandi, bashpata (Danio devario), tengra, kakra (Scylla serrata), meani, shrimps, and prawn are found in the district. However, some of these varieties, specially those which inhabit the marshes and tanks, are dwindling due to over catching and other reasons such as use of insecticides and pesticides for crop production, etc.

In addition, some exotic varieties of fish such as telapia (Oreochromis mossambicus), nilotica (Oreochromis niloticus), silver carp (Hypophthadmicthys molitrix), grass carp (Cteopharyngodon idella) are also cultivated in the district and they are also becoming very popular.

## **Concepts and Definitions**

#### 1. Population and Housing Census 2011

The population and housing census is the unique source of reliable and comprehensive data about the size of the population of the country, major socio-economic and socio-demographic characteristics.

It is the total process of collecting, compiling, evaluating, analyzing and publishing or otherwise disseminating demographic, economic and social data pertaining, at a specified time, to all persons in a country. The essential features of a population census are individual enumeration, universality within a defined territory, simultaneity and defined periodicity.

The population and housing census provides information on the geographic and administrative distribution of the population and household in addition to the demographic and socioeconomic characteristics of all the people in the country. The data from the census are classified, tabulated and disseminated so that political leaders, election officials, planners, national organizations including NGOs and civil society, regional and international organizations can use the data in decision-making.

The purpose of community report is to disseminate census data by communities (ward/mahalla in urban area and union/mauza/village in rural area). Data on all key variables namely area, household, population by sex and age group, ethnic population, literacy rate, marital status, school attendance, employment status and religion as well as physical facilities such as source of drinking water, sanitation, electricity and dwelling units have been presented in this report. The planners, researchers and policy makers as well as development partners and community administrators will find this report as a valuable reference for use in advising plans and programs for advancing welfare and well-being of the common people, in particular and the community in general.

#### Household

Persons, either related or unrelated, living together and taking food from the same kitchen constitute a household. A single person living and eating alone forms one-person household.

#### Literacy

It denotes ability to write a letter in any language. Literacy status assessment is made for population 7 years and over.

#### **Community**

It refers to the following five lower geographic, administrative or revenue units:

- i) **Union:** Smallest administrative rural geographic unit comprising of mauzas and villages and having union parishad institution.
- ii) **Mauza**: Mauza is the lowest administrative unit having a separate jurisdiction list number (J.L. No.) in revenue records. Every mauza has its well-demarcated cadastral map. Mauza should be distinguished from local village since a mauza may consist of one or more villages.
- iii) Village: Lowest rural geographic unit either equivalent to a mauza or part of a mauza.
- iv) **Ward:** Smallest administrative urban geographic unit comprising of mahallas and having ward council institution.
- v) Mahalla: Lowest urban geographic unit having identifiable boundaries.

#### **Urban Area**

It corresponds with area developed around a central place having such amenities as metalled roads, improved communication, electricity, gas, water supply, sewerage, sanitation and also having comparatively higher density of population with majority population in non-agricultural occupations.

- i) City Corporation: It includes city corporation area declared by the Ministry of Local Government.
- **ii) Paurashava/Municipality Area:** It includes paurashavas incorporated and administered by local government under Paurashava Ordinance, 1977.

#### 2. Agriculture Census year and reference period

The census year extends over twelve consecutive months having for different census items the different reference periods or days of data collections. Some items have a year or week reference period. Some others have a specific reference day. The different census items by their reference periods or days are shown below:

#### **Agriculture holding**

An agriculture holding is a techno-economic unit of agricultural production under single management comprising all livestock kept and all land used wholly or partly for agricultural production purposes without regard to title, legal form or size. Single management may be exercised by either an individual holder or jointly by two or more individuals or holders or by a judicial person such as a corporation, co-operative or government agency. A holding may consist of one or more parcels (fragments of land) located in one or more areas or mauzas or in more than one administrative unit or division provided that all separate parcels of fragments form parts of same technical unit under operational control of same management.

The definition covers practically all holdings/households engaged in agricultural production of both crops and livestock. Some agriculture holdings may have no significant agricultural land, e.g. holdings keeping livestock, poultry and hatcheries for which land is not an indispensable input for production.

#### Farm holding

A farm holding is defined as being an agricultural production unit having cultivated land equal to or more than 0.05 acres. Farm holdings are classified into following three broad groups:

- (a) **small:** Farm holdings having minimum cultivated land 0.05 acre but operated land more than this minimum but upto 2.49 acres.
- (b) **medium:** Farm holdings having operated land in between 2.50 to 7.49 acres.
- (c) **large**: Farm holdings having operated land 7.50 acres and above.

Small cultivated land 0.04 acre or less is generally used for kitchen garden growing mainly vegetables. Often seeds of white gourd, water gourd, pumpkin and other strains are sown on households; but these creepers spread out around house roofs and other structures. As such, the minimum cultivated land considered for qualifying to be a farm holding is 0.05 acres.

#### **Non-farm holdings**

A non-farm holding is defined as being the one which has neither cultivated nor operated land or has cultivated land less than 0.05 acre.

#### **Tenancy**

Owner holdings are those having and operating their owned land and who may or may not be leasing out land.

Tenant holdings are those having no owned land but operating land taken from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

Owner-cum-tenant holdings are those having owned land and who may or may not be leasing out their own land to others and who may be taking land from others on share cropping basis or on other terms.

#### **Agriculture work**

Agriculture work signifies all activities of holder and his/her labour force doing planning, management, and operation of a holding. It includes land preparation, sowing, weeding, harvesting, feeding and tending livestock & poultry, kitchen gardening, supervising agricultural workers, keeping farm records & accounts, preparing agriculture products for marketing (including packaging), repairing farm equipment, constructing farm buildings & fences, and engaging in land reclamation and improvement and other related activities. It excludes home and other family domestic chores.

#### Area under pond

The pond area remains under water almost through out the year. Normally, households use pond water for various domestic and sometimes agriculture purposes. Ponds are also generally used for fish culture.

In the census the pond area data were collected separately for both single ownership and joint ownership of households.

#### **Area under permanent crops**

It is the land area planted to crops which remain standing for a long period of time and do not need to be replanted after a seasonal harvest. Mango, jackfruit, coconut, guava, lemon, and other fruit varieties are all permanent crops.

#### **Current fallow**

It is land brought into cultivation but left out uncultivated in census year for fertility regaining and improvement or for other reasons.

#### Net cultivated area

This is land area actually cropped during the census year regardless of number of crops grown plus current fallow. It includes areas under temporary and permanent crops and also current fallow.

#### Permanent fallow

It is land not available for cultivation due to coming into residence and commercial & other uses. Play ground, graveyard, wild shrubs and jungles, marshy land, and the like fall in this category.

#### Irrigated area

This is area of total land brought under irrigation coverage for growing crops with irrigations done through mechanical or manual means. Irrigated area classifications fall into two categories: (1) surface water irrigation with main water sources being rivers, canals, beels, ponds, and other water bodies; and (2) underground water irrigation with water lifted by shallow tube-wells, deep tube-wells, and country traditional devices. The irrigation equipments are run by electricity, diesel or petrol, or manual labour.

#### Temporary crops gross area

Areas aggregated for all temporary crops grown in the census year have made **temporary crops gross area** greater than **temporary crops net area** since the latter has within it the same land cropped more than once in different seasons of a year.

#### **Intensity of cropping**

It is percentage of temporary crops gross area in comparison with temporary crops net area. It is expressed as follows:

Intensity of cropping = 
$$\frac{\text{Temporary crops gross area}}{\text{Temporary crops net area}} \times 100$$

#### **Cereals**

Main cereals are rice and then wheat. Other cereals are jab, barley, cheena, maize, kaun, bajra and joar.

#### **Pulses**

Main and common pulses are gram, mung, lentil, arhar, gari kalai, khesari and pea.

#### Oil seeds

Main oil seeds are rape and mustard, sesamum, linseed, groundnut, soybean, sunflower and castor.

#### Vegetables

Farmers grow both summer and winter vegetables. Main vegetables are potato, brinjal, raddish, arum, lady's finger, cauliflower, cabbage, bean, tomato, patal, gourd, cucumber, pumpkin, knoll-kal-turnip, dhundal, barbati, khirai, chichinga, carrot, kakrol and sak.

#### Cash crop

Main cash crops are jute, mesta, sunhemp, cotton, sugarcane and tobacco.

#### **Spices**

The main spices include turmeric, ginger, chillies, onion, garlic, corriander, black cumin and ani seed.

#### **Fuel crops**

Dhaincha and other smaller plants used as cooking-fuel.
