## Reported Problems

### Dodge County

At about 9:00 AM on Election Day, it was discovered that a portion of one precinct was missing the **Cuming County Public Power District Subdivision 2** race. Supplemental ballots were delivered to the precinct at approximately 10 AM. Twelve early voters and 28 voters at the polling site did not receive the corrected ballots. As the margin in the race was 69 votes, the error did not impact the final result.

### Saline County

Shortly after the beginning of early voting, it was discovered that one precinct was missing the **Lower Big Blue Natural Resources District Subdistrict 3** race. At that time 4 early voting ballots had been mailed. The ballot for that precinct was reprinted and the four voters were contacted. One declined a new ballot and the other 3 voters received, voted, and returned the ballot as well as the incorrect ballot which was marked as spoiled. As the margin in the race was 72 votes, the error did not impact the final result.

### Sioux County

On October 24<sup>th</sup>, it was discovered that the voting instructions on the **Upper Niobrara White Natural Resource District Subdistrict 5 and At Large** races were incorrect. The instructions indicated that the voter should vote for up to two, when it should have been vote for one. At that time 64 early voting ballots had been previously sent. Attempts were made to contact the 64 voters, reaching 53 of the 64. Seven voters requested and were sent the corrected ballot. As the margins in the races were 1940 votes (Subdistrict 5) and 618 votes (At Large), the error did not impact the final result.

### Valley County

At about 9:30 AM on Election Day it was discovered that the **Loup Valleys Rural Public Power District At Large** race was not on the ballot in a portion of one precinct. Supplemental ballots were prepared and delivered to the polling site at approximately 11:30. Seven voters had voted previously at the polls and no early voting ballots had been sent for that portion of the precinct. As the margin in the race was 128 votes, the error did not impact the final result.
