In less than 40 seconds you will arrive at Level 88 in the fastest lifts in the Southern Hemisphere and be amazed by the awesome views of Melbourne from the floor to ceiling windows.

Soundscapes & LEDs

Is that a train I can hear? Listen to the sounds that make Melbourne marvelous whilst you read up on some of the quirky information on the LED displays.

EdgeShop

Purchase tickets for the Edge Experience, Edge merchandise, film, cameras and batteries. The EdgeShop also sells souvenir photos of your experience in 'The Edge'.

Kiosk

The Kiosk is located on Level 88 and offers takeaway coffees, soft drinks and snacks.

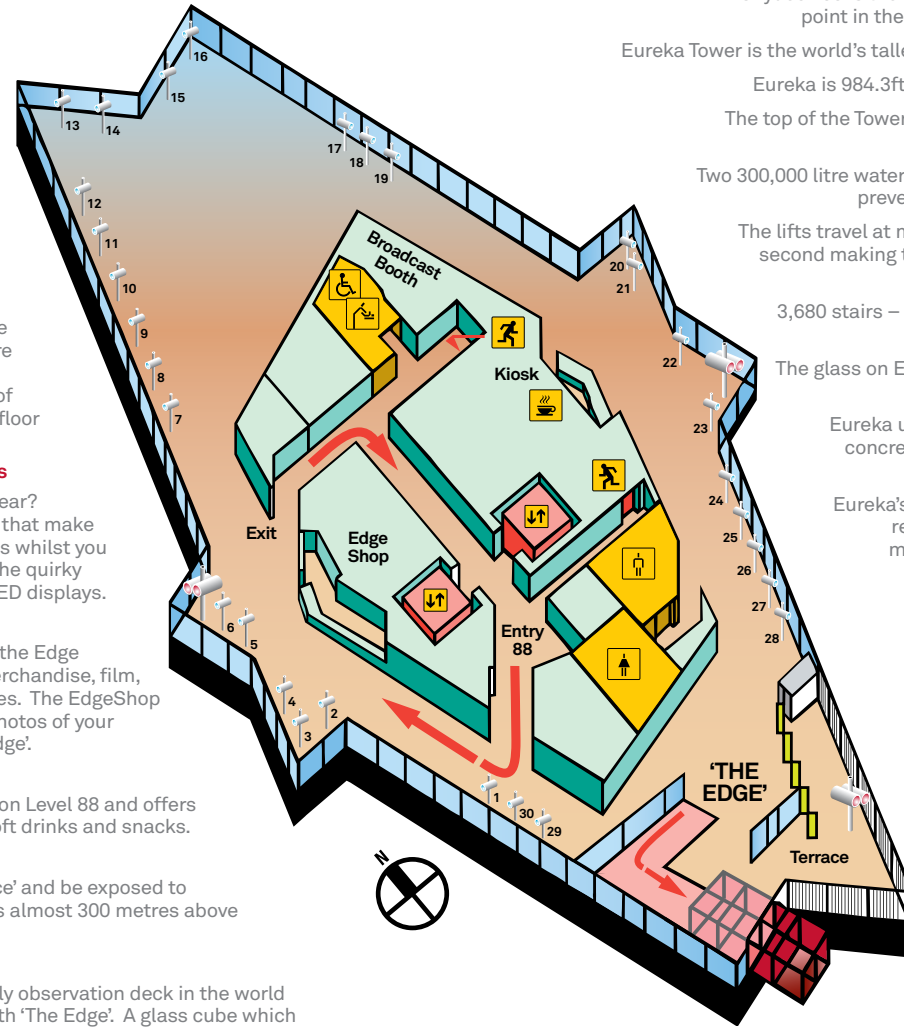
The Terrace

Step onto 'The Terrace' and be exposed to the outside elements almost 300 metres above the ground.

The Edge

Skydeck 88 is the only observation deck in the world that can thrill you with 'The Edge'. A glass cube which projects 3 metres out of the building, 300 metres up – with you in it!

Tickets for the Edge Experience can be purchased from the EdgeShop – no cameras allowed – see edge warnings.



Skydeck 88 is the highest public vantage point in the Southern Hemisphere
 Eureka Tower is the world's tallest residential building
 Eureka is 984.3ft / 300 metres in height
 The top of the Tower can flex up to 600mm in high winds
 Two 300,000 litre water tanks on level 90 & 91 prevent any excess swaying

The lifts travel at more than 9 metres per second making them the fastest in the Southern Hemisphere

3,680 stairs – 92 storeys – 52,000 sq metres of windows

The glass on Eureka's top 10 levels is 24 carat gold plated

Eureka used 110,000 tonnes of concrete and weighs 200,000 tonnes

Eureka's white horizontal lines represent the linear line markings on a surveyors measuring staff

View the short film that showcases the Eureka Tower's special features and how it came to be.

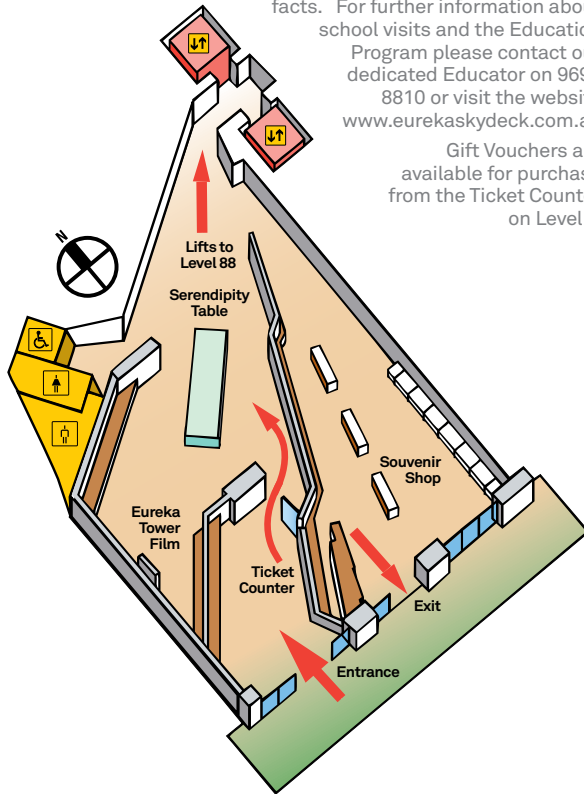
