

MISSOURI STATEWIDE REPUBLICAN PRIMARY

2015

Survey conducted October 23 through October 24, 2015. 1,033 likely Republican primary voters participated in the survey. Survey weighted to match expected turnout demographics for the 2016 Republican Primary Election. Margin of Error is +/-3% with a 95% level of confidence. Totals do not always equal 100% due to rounding. Margins of Error within specific demographics (crosstabs) is significantly higher due to smaller sample size.
