**जै jai**, cl. I. *jāyati*, to wane, perish, Dhātup. xxii, 17; cf. *kshai*.

**जैकशून्य jaikaśūnya**, m. N. of a man, Pravar. i, 1 (vv. ll. *je* & *jihvāś*).

**जैगीषव्य jaigishavya**, m. patr. fr. *jigishū* (g. *gargāddī*), N. of an ancient Rishi (named along with Asita Devala), MBh. ii, ix, xii f.; Hariv. 952; VarBrS. iii, 62; BhP. ix, 21, 26. **Jaigishavyēśvara**, n. N. of a Liṅga in Bāraṇasī, KāśīKh. lxiii.

**Jaigishavyāyanī**, f. of *vyā*, g. *lohitddī*.

**जैज्ञा॒ जैज्ञा॑ jaijjāta**, m. (= *jaiyāta*) N. of an author on medicine, Tōdar.; Bhpr.; (*jejj*) *Nid.*, Sch.

**जैच jaītra**, mf(i)n. (fr. *ji*) victorious, triumphant, superior, RV. i, 102, 3; x, 103, 5; MBh.; Ragh. &c.; leading to victory, RV.; ŠBr. xiii; ĀśvSr. iv, 13; MBh. &c.; m. a conqueror, W.; N. of a son of Dhṛita-rāshṭra, ix, 1404; n. victory, triumph, superiority, RV.; AV. xx; TBr. ii; (*i*), f. Sesbania ægyptiaca, L. — **ratha**, m. a triumphant car, Daś.

**Jaitrāyana**, patr., Pravar. iii, 1 (v. l. *caitr*).

**Jaina**, mf(i)n. relating to the Jinas, Sarvad. iii f.; Pārvan. ii, 36; m. a worshipper of the Jinas, Jaina, Sarvad. iii, vii, xi; = *नृज*, N. of a prince of Kaśmir; (*i*), f. the Jaina doctrine, Hcar. viii. — **taramgīnī**, f. a history of Kaśmir by Śri-vara. — **nagara**, n. N. of a town built by prince Jaina. — **pāla**, m. N. of a man. **Jaināyatana**, n. a Jaina monastery, Daś. vii. **Jaināsrama**, m. id., L. **Jainēndra**, m. N. of a grammarian; cf. *jin*; n. Jinēndra's grammar; — *vya-karana*, n. N. of a grammar by Abhaya-nandi (commented on by Deva-nandi, Abhaya- & Soma-deva).

**Jainya**, mfn. relating to the Jainas.

**Jaipāla**, *laka*, irr. for *jaya-p*, Croton, Bhpr. **Jaimani**, m. patr. fr. *jēman*, Pravar. iv, I & vi, 3 (v. l.) **Jaimantāyana**, v. l. for *jīvantyāy*.

**Jaimini**, m. (= *manī*) N. of a celebrated sage and philosopher (he was a pupil of Vyāsa [who made over to him the SV., BhP. i, 4, 21; Vāyup.], Sāmav-Br.; MBh. i, f., xii; and was Udgātṛi priest at Janamejaya's snake-sacrifice, i, 2046; and was founder of the Pūrva- or Karma-Mimānsā, Pañcat.; Madhus.), ĀśvGr. iii, 4; SāṅkhGr.; Pravar. i, 4; iv, 1; Hariv.; Bādar. &c. — **kadāra**, m. = *kaḍāra-jaimini*, the red Jaimini, Pāñ. ii, 2, 38, Kāś. — **koṣa-sūtra**, n. N. of a work. — **bhāgavata**, n. N. of a modern revision of BhP. — **bhārata**, n. N. of a modern revision of MBh. — **sūtra**, n. N. of a work, Praudh.

**Jaiminīya**, mfn. relating to or composed by Jaimini (a Dharma-śāstra), Sarvad. xii, 19; m. an adherent of Jaimini, Sāṃkar. xvi, 79; pl. N. of a school of the SV., Carap.; n. Jaimini's work, Sarvad. iv, 195. — **nyāya-mālā-vistara**, m. N. of a compendium of the Mimānsā philosophy by Mādhava.

**जैव jaīva**, mf(i)n. belonging to the living personal soul (*jīva*), Bādar. ii, 3, 47, Sch.; relating to Jupiter (Thursday, Vishṇ. lxxviii, 5); VarBr.; Sūryas.

**Jaivantāyana**, m. (Pāñ. iv, 1, 103) = *ti*, ŠBr. xiv, 7, 3, 26; Pravar. i, 4 (v. l.)

**Jaivantāyani**, fr. *jivanta*, g. *karnāddī*.

**Jaivatīka**, mfn. (cf. *jivātu*) long-lived, one for whom long life is desired, Daś. viii, 4 (voc.); thin, lean, L.; m. the moon, Bhām. ii, 76; camphor, L.; a peasant, Uṇ., Sch.; a medicament, L.; a son, L.

**Jaivi**, fr. *jīva*, g. *sutamgamāddī*.

**Jaiveya**, m. patr. fr. *jīva*, g. *subhrddī*.

**जैषाव jaishāva**, mfn. fr. *jishṇu*, W.

**जैहनवक jaihnāvaka**, as, m. a prince of the Jihnuś, Pāñ. iv, 2, 104, Vārtt. 28, Pat.

**जैहमति jaihmati**, m. patr., Pravar. i, 1.

**Jaihmākani**, m. patr., ib. (vv. ll. *māshmani*

[for *māshmani*] & *jihmaka*). **Jaihmāśineya**, m. patr. fr. *jihmāśin*, Pāñ. vi, 4, 174; g. *subhrddī*.

**Jaihmi**, m. patr. fr. *jihmā*, Pravar. vi, 3 (v. l.)

**Jaihmya**, n. (fr. *jihmā*) 'crookedness,' deceit, falsehood, Mn. xi, 68; Yājñ. iii, 229; Vyavahārat.

**जैहू॒ जैह्वा॑ jaīhva**, mfn. lying on or relating to the tongue (*jihvā*), Suparn. xvii, 1; Bālar. i, 14.

**Jaihvalāyani**, patr. fr. *jihvala*, Pravar. ii, 2, 1.

**Jaihvākāta**, mfn. fr. *jihvā-kātya*, Pāñ. i, 1, 73, Vārtt. 8. **Jaihvya**, n. the sense of taste in the tongue, BhP. iv, 29, 54; vii, 6, 13 & 15, 18.

**जोगू॒ jōgū**, mfn. (*√gu*) praising, RV. x, 53.

**जोङ्गं॒ joṅga**, n. (cf. *juṅga*) aloe wood, L.

**Joṅgaka**, n. id., Bhpr. v, 2, 21; cf. *°gala*.

**जोङ्ग॒ जोङ्गाता॑ joṅgāta**, m. = *dohada*, L.

**जोङ्गल॒ joṅgala**, m. = *°gaka*, Npr.

**जोटङ्गं॒ joṭīṅga**, m. an ascetic who subjects himself to severe penances, L.; Śiva, L.

**जोट॒ जोटा॑ joṭa**, ifc. the chin (e.g. *a-*, *asva-*, *eka-*, *khara-*, *go-*, *marka-*, *sūkara-*, *hashti-*; *jahi-*), L.

**जोतिक॒ jotika**, m. N. of a family, Ratnak.

**जोनराज॒ jona-rāja**, m. N. of the author of Rājat. (commenced A.D. 1148).

**जोवाला॒ jonnālā**, f. = *yavanāla*, L.

**जोमा॒ jomā**, f. a kind of broth, Divyāv.

**जोल॒ jola**, N. of a mixed caste, BrahmavP. i, 9, 121 (also *°lā jāti*).

**जोष॒ jōsha**, m. (*√jush*) satisfaction, approval, pleasure, RV. i, 120, 1; *jōsham* á or *ánuj* 'according to one's pleasure, to one's satisfaction', RV.; silence, Naish. v, 78; (*am*), ind. (g. *svar-ādī*) according to one's wish or liking, RV.; with *√āś* [MBh. ii, vii f., xii, xv; Šak. v, 18], *√I. as* [Naish. vi, 107; Pārvan. iii, 168], *√sthā* [KāśīKh.], to remain quiet or silent; cf. *ā-sa-jōsha*, *yathā-jōsham*. — **vākā**, m. chattering nonsense, RV. vi, 59, 4.

**Joshana**, n. ifc. liking, BhP. iii, 25, 25; 'choosing,' see *bhūmi-joshand*; approval, W.; (*ā*), f. expression of satisfaction by the word *jush*, KātySr. v.

**Joshayitavya**, mfn. to be approved without reflection, Nir. v, 21. **Jōshayitṛi**, mfn. = *jōshīṛi*, ŠBr. ix, 2, 3, 10 (superl. -*tama*); Nir. ix, 41f. (f. *°ṛi*).

**Joshas**. See *vt*, *sa-jōshas*.

**जोहूत्र॒ johūtra**, mfn. (*√hve*) making noise, RV. ii, 10, 1; challenging, 20, 3; neighing, i, 118, 9.

**जौमर॒ jaumara**, n. Jumara's grammar; m. pl. the followers of Jumara, Durgād. on Vop.

**जौलायनभक्त॒ jaulāyana-bhakta**, mfn. inhabited by the Jauļāyanas, g. *aishukāry-ādi*.

**जौहूत्र॒ jauhava**, mfn. relating to the sacrificial ladle (*juhū*), KātySr. vi, 7, 6.

**जौहोत्रादिक॒ jauhotyādika**, mfn. belonging to *jauhoty-ādi*, Pāñ. iii, 1, 56, Siddh.

**जै १. jñā**, for १. *jñū*. See *ūrdhva*.
