

PAIUTE VOCABULARY LIST

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As mentioned in the preface, the Paiute language varies from Paiute Band to Paiute Band, from Kanosh, Utah, to Las Vegas, Nevada. The words in the vocabulary list sometimes have 3-4 different pronunciations by it; depending on where the Paiute is from will determine how to pronounce the word correctly. There is no perfect Paiute word for every English word. Some words you will find are in two separate places. The Paiute word can have 3-4 different meanings associated with it. The list is in alphabetical order to make it easier to look up a word.
