

MISSOURI DEMOCRATIC PRIMARY ELECTION 2016

Survey conducted July 15 – July 16, 2016. 1,119 likely Democratic primary voters participated in the survey. Survey weighted to match expected turnout demographics for the 2016 Democratic Primary Election. Margin of Error is +/-3%. Margins of Error within specific demographics (crosstabs) is significantly higher due to smaller sample size. Totals do not always equal 100% due to rounding. Survey conducted by Remington Research Group on behalf of Missouri Scout.

Russ Carnahan: 54% Tommie Pierson: 5% Winston Apple: 4% Undecided: 37%

Robin Smith: 41% Bill Clinton Young: 9% MD Rabbi Alam: 7% Undecided: 43%

Q: The candidates in the Democratic primary election for State Treasurer are Pat Contreras and Judy Baker. If the election were held today, for whom would you vote?

Judy Baker: 35% Pat Contreras: 14% Undecided: 51%
