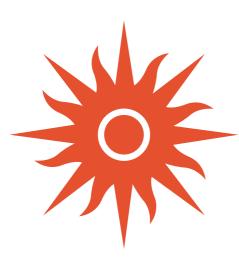

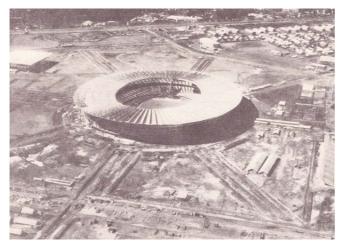
The 18th Asian Games will once again be held in Indonesia in 2018. This time the honour to host will be shared between two cities, Jakarta and Palembang.

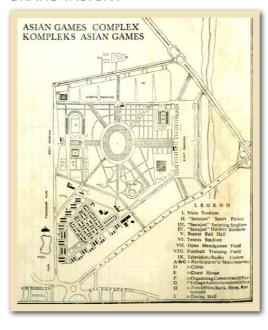

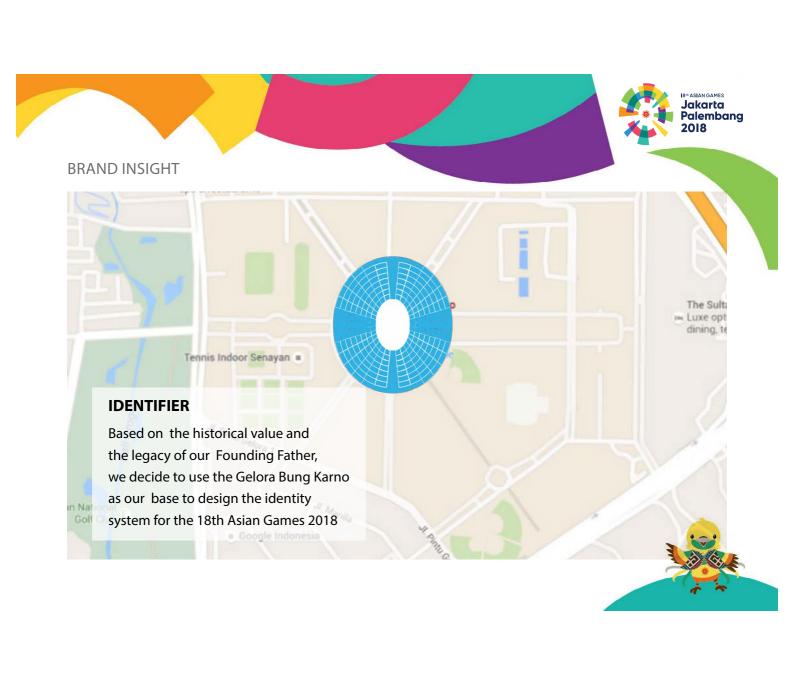


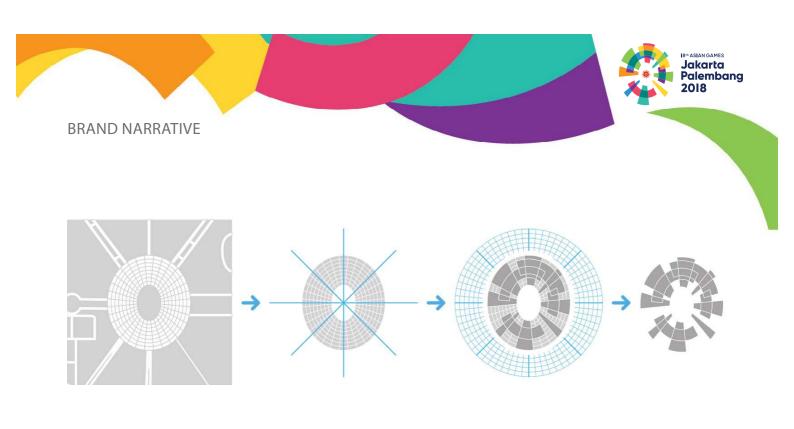
At the time of its completion in 1962, the main stadium (SUGBK) was the first of its kind with huge steel roof construction that forms a gigantic ring called temu gelang (joined ring).

For Soekarno, the role of GBK is more then just as a sports complex or to strengthen the bonds between nations through sport, but also to grow our own pride as a free nation.

Built for the 1962 Asian Games by President Soekarno, the complex is both a historical memento, and a national pride.

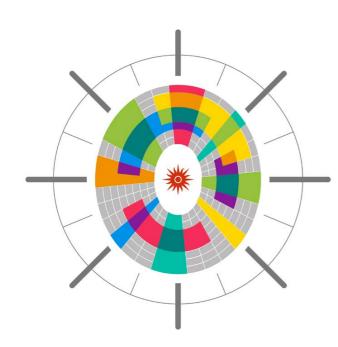








BRAND NARRATIVE
