Minutes of the seventeenth and adjourned Regular Monthly Meeting of the STATE HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT, held in its temporary offices pursuant to adjournment. The following members were present.

The meeting was duly called to order by Mr. Hancock, Chairman, and the following proceedings were had.

The Commission met at call of Chairman Curtis Hancock to receive petition from delegation from Rusk County.

Chairman Hancock addressed the delegation.

Mr. E. B. Alford, of Henderson, presented petition as follows:

"State Highway Department,
Austin, Texas.

Gentlemen:

We, the Committee from Rusk County, respectfully petition that the following named highway be designated by your Honorable Commission for adoption in your State Highway System of Highway.

Highway No. 26, from Tyler; thence to Overton; thence to Henderson; thence to Mt. Enterprise; thence to Nacogdoches. Parts of this Highway are already completed.

On motion of Mr. H. C. Odle, seconded by Mr. McLean, the petition was granted.

On motion of Mr. McLean, seconded by Mr. Odle, the following order was adopted: "Be it ordered by the State Highway Commission that Highway No. 26, to be known as Tyler-Henderson-Nacogdoches Highway, be adopted as a part of the system of State Highways, said road being more particularly described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at Tyler to connect with Highway No. 15; thence to Overton; thence to Henderson; thence to Nacogdoches; to connect with formerly adopted State Highway No. 21.

Matters of general interest and the regular routine of business was transacted.

No further business coming before the Commission, adjournment was taken until Tuesday, July 3rd, at 10 o'clock A.M.
