

## MRS. MARY HINTON A SUICIDE.

Writer Said "Life Is Something We Have the Privilege of Ending."

WASHINGTON, May 28.—Mrs. Mary Hinton, formerly of London, England, once a frequent contributor to English and American magazines, committed suicide at her home here early to-day by asphyxiation. She was 53 years old.

One of her recent statements was that "life is something we have the privilege of ending when we choose. When I think it is time to die I shall end it all."
