### ADA's 1982 Voting Record

The Senate's otherwise "abysmal" performance in 1982 had a few bright spots, according to Leon Shull, ADA's national director: action on the Voting Rights Act, rejection of the New Right agenda on school prayer and abortion, and the override of the Reagan budget veto.

"And on the other side of Capitol Hill, the House also demonstrated some independence on several issues, but on crucial questions—emergency jobs legislation, for example—the House, like the Senate, failed to meet its responsibilities," he adds.

Analysis of the 1982 record reveals that 63 percent of Senate Democrats were "liberal," with ADA scores of 70 to 100; 24 percent were "moderate" (40 to 69), and 13 percent were "conservative" (below 40).

But only 9 percent of Senate Republicans had liberal records in 1982, and only 19 percent had moderate records; 72 percent scored below 40.

The voting record thus dramatically demonstrates the absence of a liberal or moderate wing in today's Republican Party. Only 15 percent of House Republicans, for example, scored higher than 35.

Among House Democrats, on the other hand, 56 percent had scores of 70 or above, while only 21 percent had moderate scores and 23 percent had conservative scores.

Looking at the 1982 Voting Record and the 1982 election results, Shull says all indications "suggest that the 98th Congress will be more liberal than the 97th.

"Among ADA-endorsed House candidates, 75 percent were elected, and in a number of key races, liberal newcomers replaced Reagan clones who were thrown out by the voters.

"The average House incumbent winner has a 1982 ADA score over a dozen points higher than the average loser," Shull notes.

#### Senate scores begin on Page 4. House scores begin on Page 9.

"Two thirds of the Representatives who were either defeated or retired had voting record scores significantly below the average of the House as a whole. Over half the losers and retirees were extreme right-wingers, with scores of 25 or less."

And he adds optimistically, "The November elections showed clearly that the House is moving decisively away from the President."

#### Highs and Lows

Three Democratic Senators, Bill Bradley (N.J.), Christopher Dodd (Conn.), and Howard Metzenbaum (Ohio), scored 100.

And three Republican Senators, John East and Jesse Helms of North

Carolina and Mack Mattingly of Georgia, received zeroes.

In the House, 14 Representatives—all Democrats—earned scores of 100, and 27—all but one a Republican—received zeroes.

Some interesting differences between 1981 and 1982 records emerged. The averaged scores of first-term Representatives showed a dramatic jump from 19 percent in 1981 to 34 percent in 1982.

Six Senators showed a difference of 30 or more points between their '81 and '82 scores. All were Republicans, and the scores of all six increased, suggesting that Senators who altered their positions significantly voted more liberally in 1982.

The six are John Chaffee (R.I.), moving from 45 in 1981 to 80 in 1982; David Durenberger (Minn.), moving from 40 to 70; Slade Gorton (Wash.), moving from 10 to 45; John Heinz (Pa.), moving from 35 to 70; William Roth (Del.), moving from 20 to 50; and Robert Stafford (Vt.), moving from 35 to 65. □

### But Don't Turn the Page Yet...

ADA's Voting Record has been issued each year since ADA's founding in 1947. Issues are selected by a committee of ADA members, and cover a gamut of judicial, social, economic, foreign, and military policy.

Votes selected display sharp liberal/conservative divisions. ADA often chooses procedural votes, since votes on rules for debate, procedures for amending bills, or amendments themselves may reveal basic attitudes obscured in the final vote. Note, too, that ADA often supports legislation which falls short of our goals; something is frequently better than nothing.

Each Member is rated plus or minus on each vote. A live pair in favor of the liberal position earns a

Member a plus, but a dead pair in favor of the liberal position does not. (Pairing is a traditional courtesy, an agreement between a proponent and an opponent that each will refrain from voting, since their votes would cancel each other. In a dead pair both Members are absent; in a live pair, one is present and would have voted had he/she not been paired.)

This voting record is offered as a guide in judging the legislative performance of U.S. Senators and Representatives. But it does not measure work in committee, and it does not reflect the failure of Congress to deal with certain major issues, nor an individual legislator's degree of responsibility.

# United States Senate

## Domestic Issues

1. **School Busing Helms (R-N.C.)-Johnston (D-La.)** amendment to prevent the Justice Department from bringing any legal action that could lead to court-ordered busing; to bar federal courts from ordering busing; and to allow the Attorney General to re-open existing busing orders.

Adopted 58-38, February 4

2. **Secret Agents' Identities—Civil Liberties Chaffee (R-R.I.)** amendment to provide that private persons can be convicted of criminally exposing U.S. secret agents if they had "reason to believe" their acts would harm U.S. intelligence, as opposed to having an "intent" to harm.

Adopted 55-39, March 17.

3. **Federal Budget—Jobless Benefits Dole (R-Kan.)** motion to table (kill) the Byrd (D-W.Va.) amendment to increase budget authority and outlays to accommodate a 13-week extension of unemployment benefits in states suffering high unemployment.

Adopted 52-42, May 21.

4. **Voting Rights Act Extension Stevens (R-Alaska)** amendment to ease provisions allowing covered jurisdictions to "bail out" (escape from the Act's coverage).

Rejected 38-59, June 17.

5. **Family Farms v. Corporate Welfare Lugar (R-Ind.)** amendment to permit reclamation water service at existing rates to an individual farm of up to 320 acres, to permit water service at half a rate set by a new "full-cost" formula for additional farm acreage between 320 acres and 960 acres, and to permit water service to farm acreage exceeding 960 acres at the new "full-cost" rate.

Rejected 39-58, July 15.

6. **Income Tax Cuts Mitchell (D-Maine)** amendment to replace the 10-percent across-the-board individual income tax cuts scheduled for July 1982 and 1983 with cuts skewed to benefit those earning less than \$50,000.

Rejected 43-53, July 22.

7. **Interest and Dividend Withholding Kasten (R-Wis.)** amendment to kill the provision requiring a 10-percent withholding from interest and dividends.

Rejected 48-49, July 22.

A vote NO is a +

8. **Balanced Budget Amendment Passage** of the joint resolution to propose a constitutional amendment to require a balanced budget unless a three-fifths majority of Congress Members agreed to deficit spending.

Adopted 69-31, August 4. A two-thirds majority of those present and voting (67 in this case) in both houses is required.

9. **Reagan Veto of Supplemental Appropriations Passage**, over the President's veto, of the bill to appropriate \$14.6 billion in new fiscal 1982 budget authority for federal military and civilian pay raises, commodity credit programs, defense and other programs, and to rescind \$400.8 million in previously appropriated funds.

Passed 60-30, September 10. A two-thirds majority of those present and voting (60 in this case) in both houses is required to override a veto.

10. **Abortion Hayakawa (R-Calif.)** motion to table (kill) the Helms (R-N.C.) amendment designed to ban abortion.

Adopted 47-46, September 15.

11. **School Prayer Goldwater (R-Ariz.)** motion to table (kill) the Helms (R-N.C.) amendment barring the federal courts, including the Supreme Court, from hearing "voluntary" school prayer cases.

Rejected 47-53, September 22.

A vote YES is a +

12. **Clinch River Breeder Humphrey (R-N.H.)** amendment to bar use of funds for the Clinch River breeder reactor.

Rejected 48-49, September 29.

A vote YES is a +

13. **Jobless Benefits Dole (R-Kan.)** motion to table (kill) the Baker (R-Tenn.) motion to reconsider the vote by which the Metzenbaum (D-Ohio) amendment was rejected. The Metzenbaum amendment would have liberalized unemployment benefits by suspending certain provisions of the 1981 reconciliation legislation.

Adopted 50-48, September 29.

14. **Trade Union Political Action Hatfield (R-Ore.)** motion to table (kill) the Helms (R-N.C.) amendment barring use of union dues for a union's political messages to its members.

Adopted 62-37, September 29.

A vote YES is a +

15. **Public Works Program—Jobs Goldwater (R-Ariz.)** motion to table (kill) the Kennedy (D-Mass.) amendment to establish a new federal public works program to provide jobs.

Adopted 60-37, September 29.

A vote NO is a +

16. **Transfer of Pentagon Funds to Domestic Programs Baker (R-Tenn.)** motion to table (kill) the Riegle (D-Mich.) amendment to reduce military outlays by \$18.9 billion in fiscal 1983-85, transfer \$14 billion to four domestic programs, and allocate the remainder to deficit reduction.

Adopted 61-30, May 21.

17. **Binary Gas Tower (R-Texas)** motion to table (kill) the Hart (D-Colo.) amendment to delete funds for binary chemical weapons.

Adopted 49-45, in session beginning May 13.

18. **Pentagon Budget Baker (R-Tenn.)** motion to table (kill) the Kassebaum (R-Kan.) amendment to reduce military programs by \$35.3 billion in budget authority and \$13.9 billion in outlays.

19. **Caribbean Basin Initiative Kasten (R-Wis.)** motion to table (kill) the Dodd (D-Conn.) amendment to reduce funding for the CBI.

20. **MX Missile Baker (R-Tenn.)** motion to table (kill) the Hollings (D-S.C.) amendment to prohibit use of funds for MX missiles until Congress approves a basing mode.

**LQ** Liberal Quotient: the rating of a Member determined by the percentage of votes cast, or paired live, in support of liberal policy, measured against the number of votes counted. ADA does not count votes taken when the office is vacant (V), or when the Member answers "Present" (C) to avoid a possible conflict of interest.

- + A vote which ADA believes to be in harmony with liberal policies.
- A vote which ADA believes to be contrary to liberal policies.
- +& A live pair in favor of the liberal position.
- # A live or dead pair against the liberal position.
- & A dead pair in favor of the liberal position.

- @ The Member was absent but officially announced as opposing the liberal position.
- ? The Member did not vote or otherwise indicate a position.
