A PROCLAMATION

SUSAN DOUGAN O.B.E. GOVERNOR GENERAL

WHEREAS, by sub-section (1) of section 47 of the Constitution of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines (Cap. 10 of the Laws of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, Revised Edition 2009), it is provided that each session of Parliament shall be held at such place within Saint Vincent and the Grenadines and shall begin at such time as the Governor-General shall appoint by Proclamation;

NOW, THEREFORE, I SUSAN DOUGAN O.B.E., Governor-General of Saint Vincent and the Grenadines, do hereby appoint the said upstairs of the Court House Building as the place at which the said session shall be held on Wednesday the 22nd day of January, 2020 at 9:00 o'clock in the forenoon as the time at which the said session shall begin.
