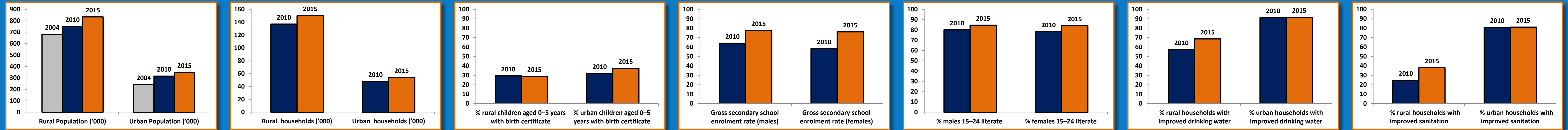

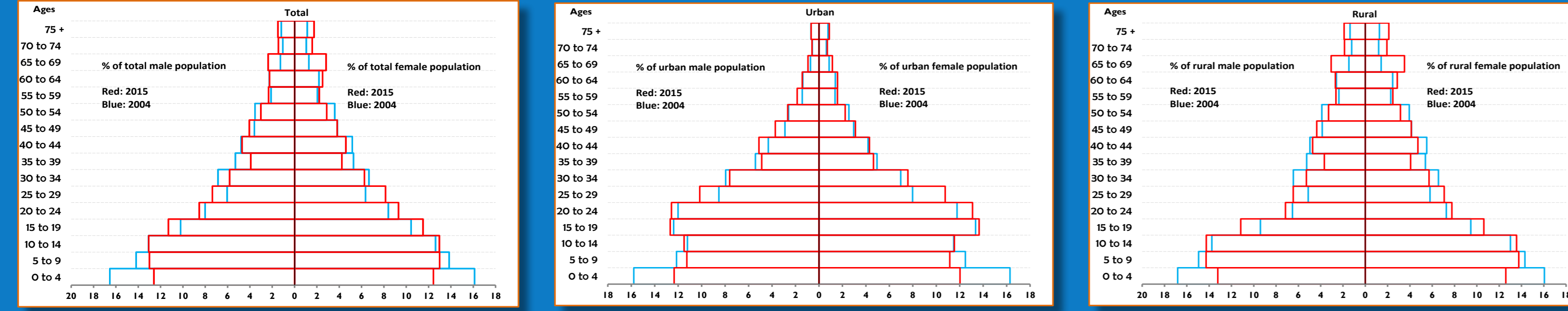

NOTES

- The number of males in the population per 100 females in the population.
- The age that divides the population into two numerically equal groups: that is, half the people are younger than this age and half are older.
- The ratio of the economically dependent part of the population to the productive part, defined as the ratio of the elderly (ages 60 and older) plus the young (under age 15) to the population in the working ages (ages 15-59).
- Square kilometers (Due to improved precision of imagery, the land area of Timor-Leste has been reduced by 35.2 km² when compared to the values used at the time of the 2010 Census of Population and Housing).
- Number of people per square kilometre.
- Number of live together in the same compound and have common housekeeping and cooking arrangements (includes single person households).
- The average number of persons occupying housing units in a defined administrative area.
- The percentage of the private household population aged 0-5 years that are orphaned.
- The proportion of Timor-Leste's working-age population (15-64 years of age) that engages actively in the labour market, either by working or looking for work, expressed as a percentage.
- The proportion of Timor-Leste's working-age population (15-64 years of age) that is employed, expressed as a percentage.

- The percentage of children aged 0-5 years from private households with a birth certificate.
- The population enrolled in primary school, regardless of age, divided by the population of the age group that officially corresponds to primary school level (0-11 years of age), expressed as a percentage.
- The population enrolled in secondary school, regardless of age, divided by the population of the age group that officially corresponds to secondary school level (12-18 years of age), expressed as a percentage.
- The percentage of population aged 15-24 years who are literate in Bahasa Indonesia, English, Tetum or Portuguese.
- Where a person experiences more than one disability, the most severe disability is used.
- Electricity and cooking gas are classified as clean energy sources for cooking.
- Improved and solar panels are classified as clean energy sources for cooking.
- Water piped into the dwelling or yard of the dwelling constitutes safe water, and improved sources comprise of public taps or standpipes, tube wells or boreholes, protected dug wells, protected springs and rainwater collection.
- Improved sanitation facilities comprise of: flushing/journing into a piped sewer system, tank or pit; a ventilated improved pit (VIP) latrine; or a pit latrine with a slab.
- Special Administrative Region of Decusse.
