

RAMAYAPATNAM

Ramayapatam is a small fishing village located on the coast of the Bay of Bengal, that once housed an old church which served as a landmark for ships cruising off the coast. A lighthouse offers a panoramic view of this gorgeous stretch of beach.

PERUPALEM BEACH

The Perupalem Beach is located at a distance of 20 km from the town of Narasapur in the West Godavari District. The beach is famous for its scenic beauty and its natural bay. The waters of the beach are shallow and safe for tourists to swim in. The way to the beach is lined with paddy fields and coconut trees on both sides of the road.

BHEEMUNIPATNAM BEACH

Bheemunipatnam or "Bheemli" is a sleepy fishing village near
Vizag, and a former Dutch settlement. Bheemli's untouched
beaches are blessed with unending expanses of golden sand,
and beautiful deep blue waters. The coastline is bordered by
tall swaying palms that add to the beauty of the place
immensely.

YARADA BEACH

Yarada Beach is situated 15 km from
Visakhapatnam, on the coast of the
Bay of Bengal. It is a quiet beach, ideal for
relaxing by the waves and sipping on cool
coconut water from the palms nearby.
The Dolphin's Nose rockland and
lighthouse are nearby tourist attractions.

RAMAKRISHNA BEACH

Ramakrishna Beach gets its name from the Ramakrishna Mission Ashram nearby. Situated almost in the heart of Vizag, it's the local favourite seaside spot. Museums, temples and several small eateries are located along the beach. The Matsyadarshini Aquarium and the Submarine Museum are major tourist attractions in the area.
