12. particular size, weight and style of a typeface

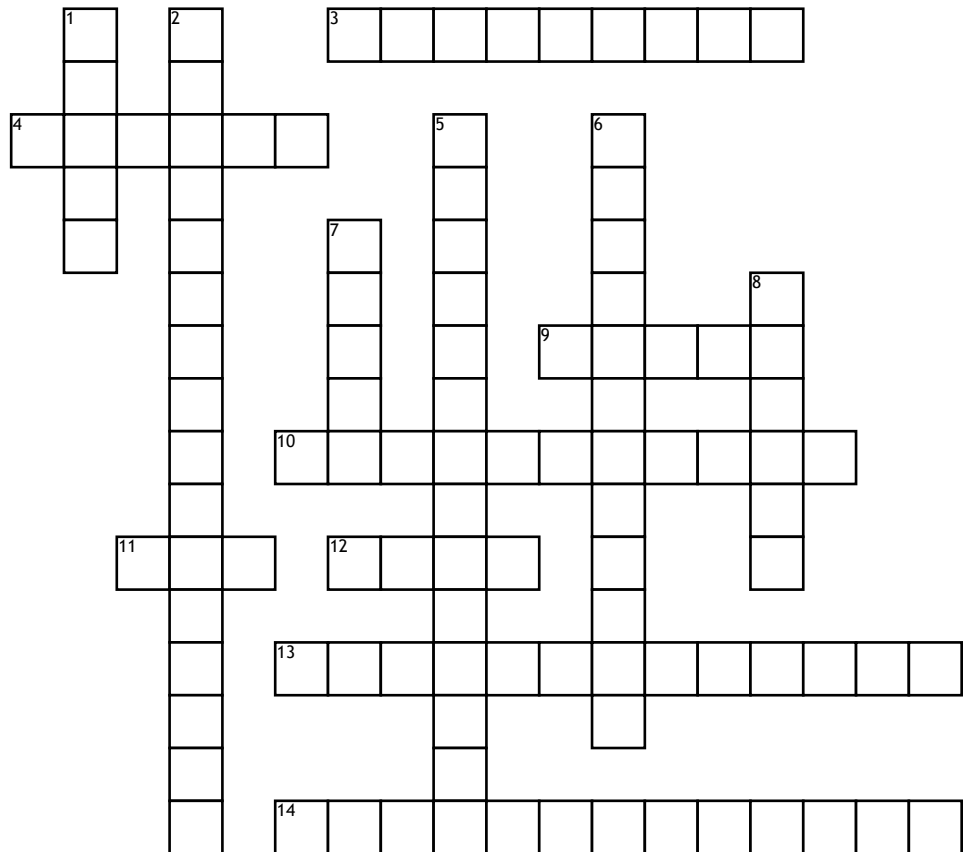
13. any form of media that uses electronic devices for distribution
