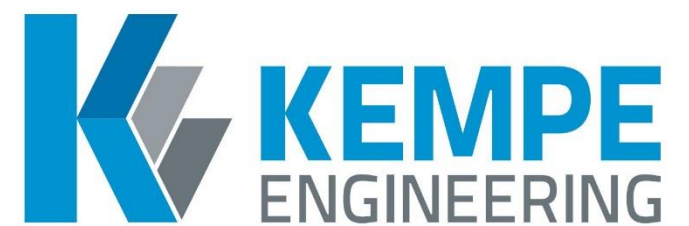

CHAIRMAN REPORT



Welcome to the AFL Barwon Annual General Meeting for 2016. This is the 4th AGM since the inception of the Commission.

This AFL Barwon region is indeed blessed with outstanding volunteers who underpin the success of our Football and Netball clubs. Not only do our volunteers provide the environment in which our games of Football and Netball can grow and flourish - they provide leadership to our wider community and create opportunities for participants and fans to enjoy the benefits of engaging with our great games of Football and Netball. A recent independent LaTrobe University study found that for every \$1 spent on a community Football Netball club there is more than \$4 in value returned to that community. We can all be very proud of the positive impact our clubs have in our local communities.

Our volunteer network relies on the support of dedicated and professional people who ensure the efficient operation of our competitions. AFL Barwon is committed to ensuring the best possible support and governance for all stakeholders.

At our first AGM we reported on the initiatives undertaken in 2013:

- Club Health Checks
- Development of a Business model to support the Regional Administration Centre
- Development of a Situation Analysis
- Development of the AFL Barwon Strategic Plan

At the 2014 AGM we added the following programs and policies to the agenda:

- AFL Vic Player Payments review
- Highton office upgrade
- Appointment of a Regional Director of Umpiring
- G21 Regional Strategy
- Club development
- Competition structure review

At the 2015 AGM we reported:

- The release of the Club sustainability programs represented by the Player Payment policy and the Player Points system for implementation in 2016
- Adoption and release of the AFL Barwon G21 Regional Strategy
- Completion of Highton office upgrade
- Ongoing consultation on Competition Review

All of the above initiatives were drawn from the Strategic Plan 2014-2017. The Strategic Plan is in the process of being reviewed with the updated draft version under consideration by the Commission. This document will be completed and adopted before the end of this year. It will provide clarity for the AFL Barwon Commission and all of our affiliates which will enable us to drive growth and sustainability in our clubs.

Following feedback received on the Competition Restructure document the Commission announced the starting date for this policy will be pushed out to the 2019 season. AFL Barwon will be working with the clubs to communicate the detail in the program and to provide clarity around the implementation. The Commission will also continue to seek feedback on the Club Sustainability programs to be able to make adjustments where necessary to improve the system and to ensure that compliance is assured.

The Commission has announced the terms of reference for the Junior Football review. Every club will be engaged in this process as we seek to establish the best model for our Junior Football competitions – based on the best available data. The Netball program will be subject to a similar review with the terms of reference to be finalised in the coming months. These will both be very important projects that will ensure that we can plan for the future to drive growth and sustainability in our games and clubs.

It is the Primary role of the Commission to provide sound governance and leadership. I urge all of our affiliates to engage in the programs outlined to ensure that together we can make our Football and Netball competitions the best that they can be.

This AGM will see our first election ballot to determine who will be the three elected commissioners for this term (2016-2019). It is pleasing to see 6 nominees to fill the 3 available positions. This is a very healthy situation.

I would like to thank all of our clubs and leagues for the welcome they have extended to me and to the Commissioners during the season. It is a pleasure to participate in such a professional environment. I also thank the AFL Barwon staff for their dedication and professionalism. To our GM Lee Hartman, and the 8 other Commissioners I extend the thanks of the AFL Barwon community for your valued efforts.

Finally I would like to acknowledge the contribution of our 2 retiring commissioners, Peter Kelly and John Wilkinson. Both of these men were appointed to the inaugural AFL Barwon Commission by AFL Victoria. They have both given great service to football and netball over a long period of time within our region. I am sure that both men will continue to provide service to our games in other roles into the future. Their wise counsel has been invaluable to me in my role as Chair. I am sure that all of our affiliates will join me in thanking Peter and John for their immense contribution. Good luck to all affiliates in 2017. I wish you all every success for the year ahead.

OPERATIONS MANAGER REPORT



AFL Barwon Operations Manager's Report

The introduction of the Points System across the State, and Salary Cap in our Region as part of the Club Sustainability program introduced some new challenges for clubs and also our Operations Staff. Many hours of work was committed to ensuring all players in each of the 4 leagues had their points calculated accurately and new players were assessed on request. Having undertaken this process, it is hoped that the ensuing years will be less tenuous and relatively straight forward.

Colts

The Under 18 ½ Colts structure continued to flourish this year, with 36 teams representing a total of 28 clubs registered for the 2016 season.

We again conducted 4 divisions with 10,8,12 & 6 teams competing respectively in each division. This was again an evenly contested year in most grades including hotly contested finals series in all grades with 3 Grand finals determined by less than 10 points. Players from 14 different clubs experienced finals football.

Interleague

This year we hosted the Worksafe Championships for all our leagues. The GFL successfully defended their mantle as not only the number one Country League in the state, but in the inaugural year of combining with Metropolitan Leagues, defeated the Eastern FL at Simonds Stadium to become the undisputed champions of Victorian Football. The Bob Cahir Memorial Medal for best player on the ground was awarded to Colac's young gun Campbell Floyd. The GFL Under 19 team came back from a scoreless first quarter to almost snatch a great win with a missed shot on the siren resulting in a 2 point loss against a strong Eastern FL side. Tom Lang from St Mary's was named the GFL's best on the day.

The BFL returned to the winner's list by comfortably defeating the Heathcote & District FNL at the newly opened Shell

Road complex in Ocean Grove. Drysdale mid fielder Mitch McGuire won the Bull Bennett Medal for best BFL player. The BFL under 18 side put on a classy display to record a resounding 21 goal victory over Heathcote & Districts, with Torquay's Thomas Diamond being named the BFL's best player.

I would like to thank our head football coaches; Jeremy Dyer, Mark Hildebrandt, Luke Daffy and Paul Liistro and their coaching staff for the time and effort that they provided during the preparation and on match day. I would also like to thank the support staff who volunteered their time and effort to ensure the players and leagues had all they needed to get the teams onto the field. Gary Holt, Brian (Bull) Bennett and Brett Pearson from the BFNL, and Charlie Johnson and his helpers from the GFNL all did a great job, as did their support staff and trainers.

BFNL

In what was an extremely close season, Geelong Amateur were again the ladder leaders at the end of the home and away season. Queenscliff finished a close 2nd, with Anglesea and Modewarre not far behind. Torquay filled 5th position just ahead of Ocean Grove and Barwon Heads. Modewarre entered the finals series with momentum and rode the wave through to a fairytale Grand Final. Geelong Amateur started strongly with a 3 goal first quarter. Modewarre was wasteful in front of goal, kicking 7 straight behinds before registering their first major. Despite a gallant fight, they lacked the firepower to match it with a powerful and talented Geelong Amateur team who have now extended their dominance of the competition to win their 3rd premiership in a row.

Ammos power forward Mitch Day again won the BFL League goal kicking with 82 goals, whilst Modewarre Coach Josh Finch created history by winning the 2016 Les Ash Medal for a record 4th time in a close count from Ocean Grove mid fielder James Linton.

GFNL

After another even season where St Mary's and Leopold headed a tight field including St Joseph's, Bell Park, Grovedale and Newtown & Chilwell, Leopold eventually took the minor premiership having only lost one home and away game for the year. Grovedale took some strong form into the finals disposing of Bell Park in the Elimination Final and St Joseph's in the 1st Semi, but met a determined Leopold outfit who were stung into action by their loss to St Mary's the week prior. Leopold steam rolled their way into a rematch with St Mary's, and after a tight struggle in the first half, kicked away in the last half kicking 10 goals to 2 goals to record an historic first ever GFL Premiership.

The Mathieson medal was another thrilling count, with one round to play, any one of 10 players were in a position to win, but Grovedale's pocket rocket Nathan Deans polled 3 votes in the last round to leap frog over team mate Jordan Erskine and runner up Leopold's Jai Thompson to win by one vote. Jordan Erskine won the Goalkicking with 78 Goals.

CDFNL

The Colac & District FNL continue to grow in stature as a league, with many quality players finding their way to CDFNL teams.

Unfortunately Forrest were unable to provide enough players to field senior teams, and were forced to go into recession for the short term.

The season was again closely contested with Birregurra and South Colac leading the way ahead of Lorne, Simpson, Colac Imperials and Alvie, with Alvie just missing out on a finals berth by one game. Birregurra eventually secured top position by percentage only, with both them and South Colac only losing one game each. The finals series was evenly contested, but the top two teams found their way to the Grand Final, with Birregurra winning a tight tussle, only breaking clear in the dying minutes.

The Mahoney Medal was again an amazing count with 3 players entering round 18 separated only by 3 votes Alvie mid fielder Liam McGuane polled 2 votes in the final game to finish 3 votes ahead of joint runners up Birregurra pair Michael Bolitho and Tim McLean, and Sth Colac Captain Tim Speirs. South Colac spear head Ben Cox kicked his 100th goal in the Grand Final having won his 2nd consecutive goal kicking trophy with 95 goals in the home and away games.

Interleague was played at Central Reserve Colac with a clash against the Mid Gippsland Football League led by coach Adam Harris. After a slow start, the team played a great game of tough contested football, to run out comfortable winners with a 6 goal final quarter. Birregurra mid fielder Andrew Kelly took out the medal for best on the ground.

I would like to again thank our RGM Lee Hartman for his support and professional leadership. I would also like to thank and acknowledge Sean, and Sarah who have managed their respective areas professionally. Thanks also go to Jeanette Watt and Deb Thewlis for their hard work and attention to detail throughout the year as well as Maddie and Gretchen who stepped in to help Sarah fill the void left by Nikki's secondment to Netball Vic. It is always a pleasure working with such a cohesive, hardworking and competent team. I would like to express again my appreciation to all the club volunteers for their hours of work committed to ensuring all the required tasks are performed in a timely and efficient manner.

Newtown & Chilwell FNC continued their unbeaten run after another strong performance beating South Barwon in the A Grade grand final. We were again blessed with fabulous weather and this combined with no entry fees saw great crowds to all our games and enabled spectators to see both football & netball at the one venue over the finals series. I would like to thank GWSP for hosting the first week of the GFNL finals series and assisting with set-up and pack-up each day. Thank-you to St Marys FNC for the loan of your electronic scoreboard for Grand Final Day. Thank-you to all clubs and spectators for supporting our finals series and Grand Final Days both BFNL and GFNL. The crowds were fantastic this year and I know the players appreciate the support they receive – making their achievements extra special.

2016 was another big year for coaching development. 2016 saw the introduction of online coaching accreditations for the Foundation coaching accreditations. We had 171 coaches complete there Foundation accreditation online which is a huge achievement for the league. Along with this we have had 14 coaches receive a Development accreditation and 5 coaches achieve their Intermediate coaching accreditation.

AFL Barwon continued providing administrative services in 2016 to the Geelong Netball Club who play in the State VNL Competition, forging the way for AFL Regional Administration Centres to support and promote elite netball in their respective regions. AFL Goldfields have since set up a similar partnership with the newly formed VNL club Ballarat Sovereigns. It's fantastic that we can provide these services to ensure Elite Netballers in our region are being provided an environment to train and play that will enable them to reach their full potential. Our administration services supported the Geelong Flyers in developing their new Junior Development Program, an elite junior program for the Barwon Region. Our involvement with the Barwon Junior Netball Championships now means that pathways and administration services for netball across our region have been streamlined ensuring the growth in our sport can be facilitated and fostered.

Finally I would like to say thank-you to my colleagues at AFL Barwon. I look forward to 2017 and the challenges that the new season will bring. A huge thank-you to Gretchen Rivers and Maddie Smedts our Netball Co-ordinators. Both ladies have undertaken all their responsibilities with enthusiasm and professionalism. I am very grateful to the support they have provided me.

Geelong Junior Netball

In total for our Geelong Junior Netball competition this year we had 58 teams participate on a Tuesday night in the 11 & Under comp combined across the two venues Kardinia & Ocean Grove. Friday night we had 60 teams participate from 13 & Under, 15 & under and 17 & Under. Included in our 60 teams was also our 5 All abilities teams. I would like to Tim Hunt and Evan Priest from Leisure networks for all their work with this competition.

Thank you to our Friday night umpire supervisor Shirley Fagan and to the many Friday night mentors throughout the year. We had 25 new umpires begin in our Friday night competition this year and many have succeeded in becoming trainees and slowly moving up the ranks. With the help and support of our mentors we were also able to get many of our Friday night trainees back to their clubs umpiring on a Saturday.

Umpiring

As mentioned earlier in the Friday night competition we have 25 new umpires begin in our Friday night umpiring program. With this program we have over 15 mentors helping out throughout the season providing feedback and encouragement for our developing junior umpires. Along with our beginners we had over 40 trainee umpires umpiring every week on a Friday night gaining skills and confidence to work their way back to their clubs to umpire. We had 8 Friday night trainee receive there C badge throughout the year.

Our Panel umpires this year. Thank you to all clubs who supported AFL Barwon with last minute umpires of changes. This year we had more umpires available to us and we worked very hard in developing and gaining new younger members onto our panel. This program will continue in 2017 where we hope to add more Panel umpires to our list. This year I would like to congratulate one of our AFL Barwon Panel members for obtaining there B badge accreditation for umpiring. Olivia Duhamel who only joined the Panel as a trainee panel member in 2014 and has worked tirelessly with Heather Carroll to earn her accreditation.

I wouldn't have been able to get more than 22 umpires across 22 A & B grade games each week throughout the year without the help and support of the umpire development panel, Heather Carroll, Kate Harding and Cheryl Van Dreumel. With the support of these ladies not only have we allocated panel every week, but have work with umpires to get there umpiring badges.

UMPIRING REPORT



It gives me great pleasure to present my annual report for 2016.

Firstly I would like to thank all the umpire coaches and support staff in Geelong and Colac for their commitment and efforts in delivering a coaching program that has delivered improvement for all umpires, resulting in improved umpire performances in all finals games across the Region, I am very proud of the people who umpire games each week, I am particularly proud of the club affiliated umpires who, without you many games would not go ahead, so from all your peers and to every person involved in umpiring well done.

Umpire numbers across Geelong and Colac had a **positive net growth** in 2016, with Geelong reaching **362** running umpires, while Colac grew from 65 umpires to **69**. We have had another **49** people registered as participating in umpiring which was made up from registered club appointed umpires through to School based umpire academy participants.

This is a great outcome for the Region, but we have plenty more work to do, Umpiring needs more people involved as the rapid growth of the game is still well ahead of the growth of umpires numbers. **Geelong has a bold target of 700 umpires while Colac need 100+**

One of the main messages is we want people to **“give umpiring a go”**, it’s one of the best seats in the house and a way to stay in the game, ex-footballers are strongly encouraged to be part of umpiring in a supporting and welcoming environment and bring your valued experience back to the game.

As per the table below it is evident that we do have a very diverse group of people who participate in umpiring for the AFL Barwon Region. Umpiring does offer opportunities to people of all cultures, ages and gender, with strong coaching and support personal for anyone that wants to be part of the game through umpiring.

The AFL Barwon Region was very well represented with umpires and umpire coaches from Geelong and Colac in the 2016 Worksafe Country Championships, V/Line Umpire Academy and TAC Cup, with over 50 umpires involved in these programs which allowed for greater development of individual umpires by being exposed to higher opportunities the same that is offered to players. The Geelong Umpires also have 7 umpires nominated for AFL Vic. Trials for the upcoming 2017 season.

AFL Barwon was also very proud with Geelong Umpire members Nick Murnane (Field), Nick Ross-Watson (Field), Max Visintin (Boundary) and Sian Atkins (Goal) appointed to the AFL Vic Country v AFL Vic Metro match, a great accomplishment for them personally and very significant appointments for the Region, Nick, Nick, Max and Sian went on to umpire the GFNL Grand Final.

The Umpire Advocates Program (Geelong) in conjunction with Deakin University Law Student, Phillip Carapillas, leading a small team of students from Deakin University, were able to act as umpire advocates at the AFL Barwon Tribunal, the program allows these students to develop their advocacy skills in real life scenarios that had real outcomes, we continue to believe this a major value add to the student experience and also a massive plus for umpire advocating and another way AFL can connect with people who otherwise would not have been involved. Rod Stokes from Geelong Umpires also contributed to this vital program.

The major achievement for 2016 was the establishment of the AFL Barwon School based Umpire Academies, in conjunction with GSSA, GISSA and Trinity College (Colac). All Umpire Academies offered students the opportunity to complete a NUAS Level 1 Umpire Accreditation, umpire school based football matches and receive specialised umpire coaching. Six students went on to join Geelong Umpires during 2016 with many indicating they will look to umpire in 2017.

Belmont High School Hosted the GSSA Academy with 15 students participating, AFL Barwon hosted 34 students from **KIC, CCG** and **GBC** from GISSA while **Trinity College** Colac hosted 5 students. All schools are looking to continue and evolve the Umpire Academies that gives benefit to the school communities and the region in recruiting umpires through a dedicated school based program.

To the teachers involved Simone Buchanan-Huhn (BHS), Dale Hemley (CCG), Jarrod Waight (KIC) thank you for your assistance in establishing and driving participation within in your schools along with David Harris from the AFL Umpires who volunteered his time in assisting us through the season.

If there are or you know of other schools who could be interested in hosting an umpire academy in 2017 please feel free to contact me.

In closing I would like to thank the AFL Barwon Commission, AFL Barwon Staff and Geelong Umpires BoM, CDFUA, AFL Victoria Umpire Development Managers Russell O’Toole, Rod Threlfell, GDFL executive, AFL Barwon/GDFL clubs.

As we move to 2017 I continue to look forward to an exciting future for AFL Barwon, Geelong and Colac umpires as we continue to establish strategies that will recruit and importantly retain community umpires, provide pathway for our talent umpires and deliver strong coaching teams which will give us greater umpire performances to each game that is officiated in the AFL Barwon Region.

TRIBUNAL REPORT

The Regional Tribunal was again responsible for adjudicating charges laid in the Bellarine, Geelong and Geelong & District Football & Netball League as well as Geelong Junior Football.

There were a total of 128 reports laid across these leagues in the 2016 season. This was a significant increase from last year.

These reports comprised 71 Senior Grade, 14 Reserve Grade, 31 Colts, 12 from Junior Grades, which included 3 Junior Coaches. This includes 11 reports heard at Tribunal as a result of investigations at the request of Clubs, Umpires or League for various incidents, and 10 that were referred by the Match Review Panel.

44 players accepted the set penalty option. A total of 132 matches will be or have been missed by players through suspensions received in 2016. There was also a further total of 20 weeks in potential penalties suspended until the end of 2017.

4 charged Players/Coaches failed to appear at their tribunal hearing and are suspended until they have their case heard.

3 players were each suspended for 12 months, for breaches of the AFL Barwon Cybersafety Policy

Our Match Review Panel assessed 53 requests of which they found 15 reportable offences. Five of these players accepted set penalties and the other 10 charges were heard at Tribunal with 8 found guilty. Our appreciation is extended to the members of the MRP who volunteered their time on a weekly basis to assess relevant footage as requested and provide their judgements.

There were some difficult times experienced by the Tribunal members during the year, with a number of frustrations endured through the state appeals process. This resulted in the resignations of some very experienced members including long serving chairmen Phil Swindells and Geoff Stribley. I would like to thank them for their years of service and also thank Rob Sodomaco for stepping into the chairman's role at such short notice. Thanks must also go to Ron Lovell and Ron Drew for their assistance in facilitating the hearings, and our other tribunal members for always making themselves available and embracing their responsibilities. We are conducting a full review into our tribunal, MRP and Appeals processes for 2017 and beyond.

I would like to thank Rob Drew for his work as Tribunal Secretary with the co-ordination, scheduling and running of the Tribunal sessions, I would also like to thank our Director of Umpiring Jock Hillgrove for his work co-ordinating and organizing the umpires and their advocates.

AFL VIC FDM REPORT

Development

As Football Development Managers we have successfully delivered Development Programs for AFL Victoria, as well as producing critical outcomes for the AFL Barwon Region through targeted League/Club Development Programs and strategies throughout 2016.

Participation

Our continued focus of developing and supporting all pillars of the game, from NAB AFL Auskick to Open-Age football, ensured that participation across the State and Region continued to develop:

- We were able to support 2,992 NAB Auskick participants, with numbers affected by transition from Auskick through to Junior Football at an earlier age and we will be working on strategies to increase participation in our Junior Programs.
- We supported all of our AFL School Ambassadors and School Competition Programs and were fortunate enough to host all School/Multicultural Ambassadors and Auskick Coordinators at a Pre-Season Function at Simonds Stadium in March.
- We continued to promote the game of AFL 9s to school participants through the Sporting Schools Program and built upon the success of the Social Competition that is operated and ran by the Deakin YMCA.
- We conducted School Holiday Programs for 130 participants, as well as a Footy Inflatables Promotion at Waurn Ponds Shopping Centre for over 2000 kids.

Community

We supported all of the AFL Barwon affiliated Leagues in regard to the management, structure and best practices of all our Clubs, as well as developing environments that seek to motivate committee members, volunteers, umpires and coaches at all levels in the Barwon region:

- We worked with all of the GFNL, BFNL, GDFL, CDFNL, GFUL and CFUL Football and Netball Clubs to implement outcomes that are outlined in the recently released G21 and AFL Barwon Strategic Plan. This included testing all football ground lighting across the Region.
- We continued to deliver our 'Community Education Presentations' to AFL Barwon aligned Clubs, which included topics consisting of: Vilification and Discrimination, Cyberbullying, Respect and Responsibility, Gambling and Drug & Alcohol Awareness.
- We accredited over 200 coaches through our Senior, Youth and Junior/Auskick Coaching Courses.
- The Annual Coach of the Year Dinner for 205 guests was held, recognising the outstanding work of our Coaches and Volunteers in the AFL Barwon Region.
- 3 coaches/coordinators were also recognised at state level. Congratulations to Tim Foley, Peter Saw and Alissa Bellears.

Engagement

We developed engagement initiatives, particularly within the multicultural and indigenous areas, as well as continuing to engage girls into football to grow female environments into the future:

- The Geelong Diverse Academy or 'Steven Motlop Squad' continued, giving approx. 60 players from diverse backgrounds, to learn the skills of AFL and develop as players and people.
- AFL Barwon and the Geelong Cats continued to strengthen its relationship with the Next Generation Academy program gaining momentum and building on its structure leading to an exciting 2017.
- We promoted girls football through a 'Come and Try' day at Simonds and introduced a U/12 competition to develop pathways.

Fans

We worked hard to develop our 'fans of the game' by working closely with the Geelong FC:

- We coordinated all of the AFL Player Appearances for Geelong FC players at approx. 90 schools, 40 junior clubs and 40 NAB Auskick centres and extra visits.
- We ran a NAB Auskick Superclinic for approx. 1,600 participants at Simonds as well as the Geelong FC Junior member's clinic for approximately 800 kids.

Best Talent

We also successfully managed and coordinated the V/Line Cup program for 50 U/15 boys and 25 girls, as well as our active involvement with the Worksafe Community Championships, Herald Sun Shield School football and other representative games at club and school levels. This year also saw the introduction of the Colac Academy, 35 boys from the Colac region participated in the 8 session program.
