THE MOUNT: A WELSH ESTATE

Monday, October 17, BBC One Wales, 10.35pm

The Mount estate in Milford Haven is home to 400 flats and houses and is the focus of a brand new BBC Wales programme, *The Mount - A Welsh Estate*. Cameras spent a year meeting and following the people who live there as they tell their stories in their own words.

The Mount is typical of the council estates built in the 1960s and 70s to a revolutionary American design, which meant no streets and no private gardens. Like similar estates it became stigmatised by high unemployment, anti-social behaviour and numerous people living on benefits.

Roughly 70 percent of The Mount residents are unemployed, but the programme talks to Roger and Stacy Davies who are in the minority as they both are in employment. Having lived in the area for 22 years, single parent Jane is proud that her only child Simone moved away to obtain a university degree - but circumstances change and Simone is back on The Mount. And for a few people, alcohol is a problem, especially for Jo, whose two children are in care as she battles an addiction which is destroying her life.

In this magical drama Colin Morgan plays Merlin, with Bradley James as Arthur, Anthony Head as Uther Pendragon, Richard Wilson as Gaius and Katie McGrath as Morgana.

In *Lions - New Zealand 1971*, BBC Two, Wednesday, October 19, Eddie Butler tells the story and reassesses the impact of the tour - taking a journey through a rugby-mad country. "So much of our rugby is familiar, close to home. Grand Slams, the Five Nations and Six Nations, grand days out in places we know. But the finest contribution ever to Welsh rugby was made in an alien environment, as far from home as you can go," says Eddie.

The programme features contributions from many of the '71 Lions Welsh stars including Gareth Edwards, Barry John, JPR Williams, Gerald Davies and Mervyn Davies. The programme also hears from many of the stars of the All Blacks team.

Rhydd ymgais arall ar ennill arian i'r clwb drwy drefnu parti calan gaeaf yn gynnar, ond mae'r cyfan yn fethiant arall i Colin, sy'n golygu bod sefyllfa ariannol y clwb rygbi yn waeth nag erioed.

• A happy time for Gethin and Sheryl is fast turning into frustration for the new couple. Sheryl seems to be spending more nights alone now than she did before they lived together. When they finally arrange a night out, their evening is scuppered by news of Dani's arrest. DI Williams has uncovered new evidence, and much to the dismay of Dani, the detective seems to know a lot about her circumstances. Gethin deserts Sheryl and tries to protect his sister, but in so doing ends up being in the line of fire himself.

There's a feeling in Cwmderi that change is afoot as 'For Sale' signs are erected on the Deri and No 10. In an attempt to alleviate this awkward scenario, Kevin and Denzil visit Meic in Anglesey to plead with him to return. Meic tries his best to convince his son and friend that he's better off far away from Cwmderi and having the time of his life.
