# ORDER

The Respondent-Applicant filed on 11 October 2012 a MOTION TO WITHDRAW, stating among other things the following:

- "1. Applicant Nakpil, with the assistance of her counsel, respectfully manifest that she has agreed to enter into a compromise agreement with oppositors Mark Edward P. Escueta ('Escueta'), Michael Maximo C. Elgar ('Elgar') and John Paul R. Sergio ('Sergio') the terms of which are not contrary to law, morals, good customs, public order and public policy, a copy of which is attached herein as Annex 'A".
- "2. In consideration of the foregoing, Applicant Nakpil moves that she hereby withdraws her pending application for registration of the mark 'Rivermaya' with the Honorable Office and undertakes not to oppose or hinder the application for registration of the same filed or to be filed by Oppositors Escueta, Elgar and Sergio."

A scrutiny of the motion shows that it was signed in conformity by the Respondent-Applicant.

With the Respondent-Applicant's motion to withdraw her trademark application, there is no more reason or legal basis to proceed with this case.

WHEREFORE, premises considered, the instant opposition is hereby DISMISSED. Let the filewrapper of Trademark Application Serial No. 4-2008-008018 be returned, together with a copy of this Order, to the Bureau of Trademarks for information and appropriate action.
