




Lei Yue Mun Pass Battery and Historical Trail

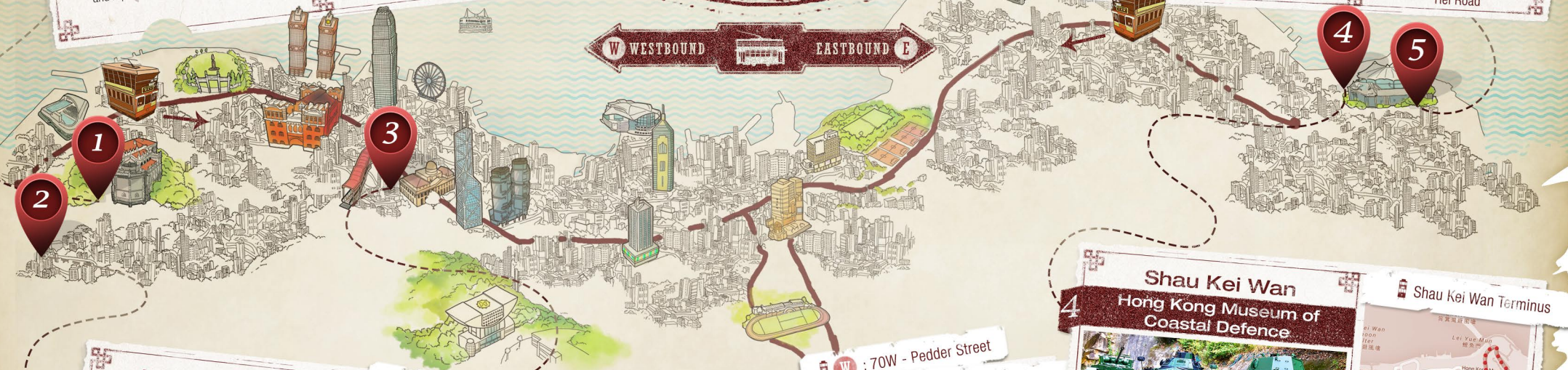


