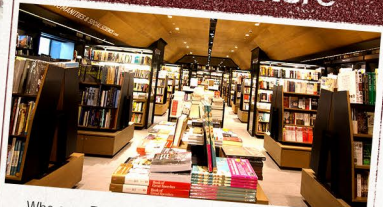
**3 Wan Chai Star Street Precinct**



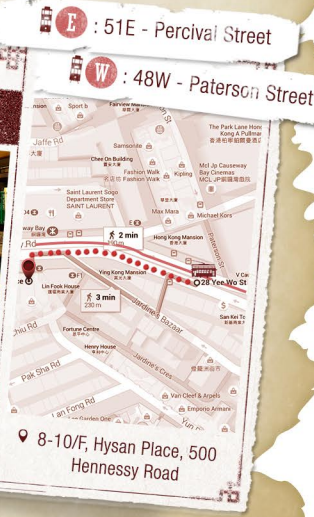
Situated at one end of Wan Chai, Star Street is a celebrated haven of many upmarket restaurants and cafes.
